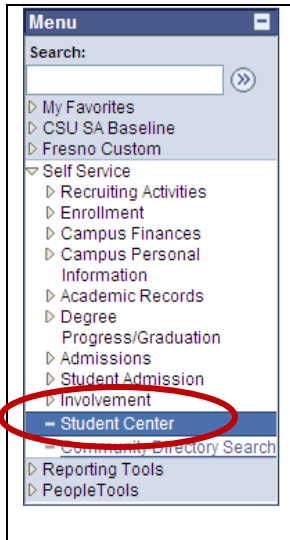
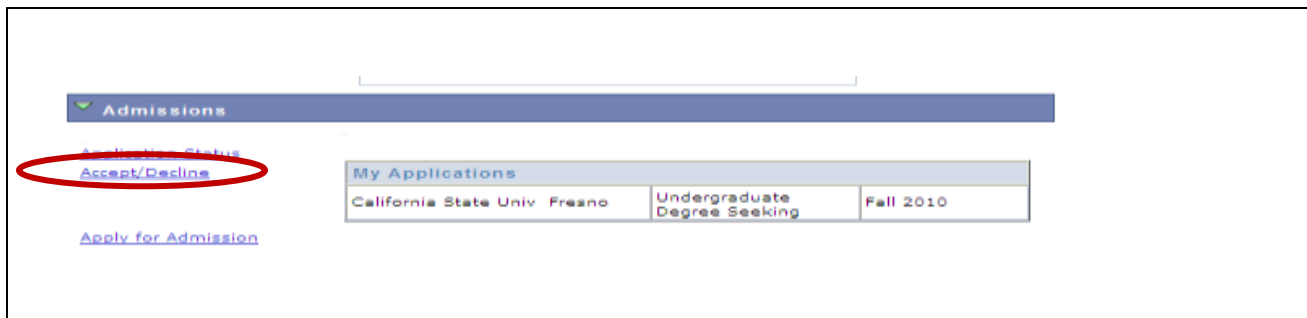


Fall 2011 FTF Accept/Decline and Dog Day Orientation Registration Steps




