

Fresno State Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) Checklist for Fall 2019 Transfer

In order to qualify for the TAG, the following requirements must be completed by the end of **SPRING 2019**.

Eligibility requirements:

- ALL** current/prior coursework must have been completed within the State Center Community College District with at least 45 units completed at Fresno City College
- Have earned **60 transferable units** by the end of spring 2019
- Complete the Golden 4/Foundation with a "C" or better by the end of spring 2019
 - A.1 - Oral Communication
 - A.2 - Written Communication
 - A.3 - Critical Thinking
 - B.4 - Quantitative Reasoning (Mathematics)
- Complete 30 units of CSU General Education courses
- Have a minimum 2.75 GPA in all transferable coursework by the end of fall 2018
- Attend a CSU application workshop in fall 2018 (by November 30, 2018)
- Attend annual mandatory advising with a Fresno City Transfer Counselor
- Attend annual mandatory advising with a Fresno State Recruitment Counselor
- Attend one mandatory University Transfer Scholars Day at Fresno State
- Meet and maintain requirements for priority registration at Fresno City College

The Fresno City to Fresno State University Transfer Scholars Program (UTSP)

Overview:

UTSP is a partnership between Fresno City College (FCC) and Fresno State to prepare and assist new FCC applicants with their transition to the university and presenting them with transfer pathways to meet their education goals.

Outcomes:

1. Students will be prepared for transfer by meeting the requirements of the Transfer Agreement Guarantee (TAG) and be well informed about pathways to complete their baccalaureate degree at Fresno State.
2. Students will meet regularly with counselors at Fresno City and Fresno State to assist them navigating and preparing for transfer.
3. Students will understand transfer requirements, pathways and will receive a transfer plan based on their major of interest.
4. Students will be aware of their transfer status by meeting annually with the Fresno City and Fresno State counseling staff.
5. Students will familiarize themselves with Fresno State, its services and programs by attending an annual event on campus.

Services:

Fresno State

- Fresno State guarantees admission to the students who meet all the requirements in the TAG.
- Fresno State will offer priority admission to UTSP transfer students who complete their TAG.
- Fresno State will provide annual counseling and major transfer advising (Required)
- Fresno State will assist students with the application and matriculation process.
- Fresno State will host an annual University Transfer Scholars Day at Fresno State (Required to attend once)

Fresno City

- Fresno City College will provide a path for High School seniors to qualify for priority registration.
- Fresno City College will provide a Comprehensive Student Educational Plan. (Required)
- Fresno City College will provide ongoing advising through the Transfer Center. (1 annual appointment required)
- Fresno City College Transfer Center will actively monitor student progress and provide 2-way communication with students.

- Fresno City College will provide support with Fresno State application.
- Fresno City College will support enrichment events at Fresno State by organizing and providing transportation.
