Program

Description:

Upward Bound (UB) is a federally funded program designed to provide academic services to first-generation and/or low-income college bound high school students. UB provides students with the necessary support and assistance to persist in high school and encourage and motivate them to enroll into a post-secondary institution. During the summer, UB provides students with academic and career classes and gives them an opportunity to obtain high school credit.

Program Dates:

June 15, 2014 through July 25, 2014 (Residential Program)
May 30th, 2014 - Student and Parent Summer Program Orientation
May 19th through May 22nd, 2014 - Mandatory Training

Salary:

\$2,437 (includes parent/student orientation, training, residential program, summer preparation/close out, and trips)
Room and Board Provided

Responsibilities:

- Ⓢ Supervise high school students in an academic and residential environment
- Ⓢ Be responsible for a group of students and documentation
- Ⓢ Be able to tutor students in various academic subjects
- Ⓢ Maintain contact with your core group and their classroom teachers
- Ⓢ Collaborate and follow instructions as delegated by the RS and permanent staff
- Ⓢ Enforce dorm rules, carry out disciplinary procedures, and report situations to Resident Supervisor or permanent staff that are deemed necessary
- Ⓢ Develop and assist in the development of engaging & purposeful evening activities for students in a residential setting
- Ⓢ Ability to develop and assist in the organization of activities for students in a residential setting
- Ⓢ Supervise students during meal times
- Ⓢ Maintain proper documentation
- Ⓢ Conduct self in a professional manner and be a positive role model for students
- Ⓢ On call for 24 hours
- Ⓢ Create a positive learning atmosphere for students
- Ⓢ Attend regular staff meetings

Requirements:

- ✓ Must have completed at least two years of post secondary education
- ✓ Have at least a 2.50 GPA
- ✓ Posses excellent leadership and supervisory skills
- ✓ Have good writing and communication skills
- ✓ Experience and ability to work with diverse populations, such as ethnic, low-income and first generation college bound students
- ✓ Demonstrate good leadership, enthusiasm, and interpersonal skills
- ✓ Be flexible
- ✓ Be familiar with laws relating to minors
- ✓ Will be fingerprinted for criminal record and **must** pass background check.
