## **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Conduct and develop 45-50 minute Healthy Relationships, Consent and Bystander Intervention presentations to classrooms, clubs and organizations as requested through the Health PAWS Presents... program.
- Prepare materials for Healthy Relationships, Consent and Bystander Intervention presentations and keep information up-to-date.
- Market the Healthy Relationships, Consent and Bystander Intervention presentation to Greek organizations and Resident Advisors at University Courtyard.
- Serve as student representative from the Student Health & Counseling Center on the Title IX Campus Multi-disciplinary Review Team.
- Serve in support of the efforts of the new campus-wide Advocate as it relates to sexual and interpersonal violence.
- Serve as Health PAWS and/or VPVA representative during tabling events.
- Participate in biweekly Health PAWS Staff meetings.
- Assist with the development of Healthy Relationship Campaigns, posters, fliers and other outreach materials.
- Assist with social media campaigns.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

## **Qualifications:**

- Must be a current Fresno State student enrolled at least half-time. Criminology/Victimology, Women's Studies, Social Work, Psychology, Public Health or related major preferred.
- Requires prior experience/and or knowledge in the area of sexual and relationship violence education.
- Must demonstrate effective written and oral communication skills.
- A team player, but also comfortable working with limited supervision.
- Ability to multitask and prioritize to meet deadlines.
- Must maintain a semester GPA of 2.0 throughout the 2015-2016 academic year.
- A one-year minimum commitment to the position is preferred.
