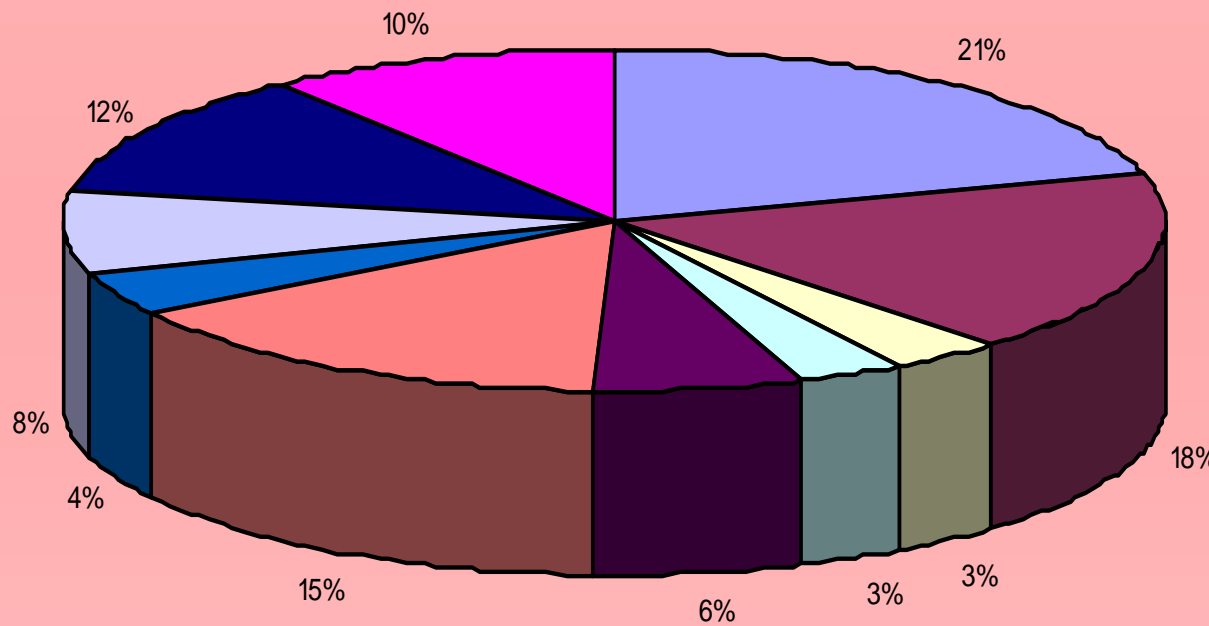

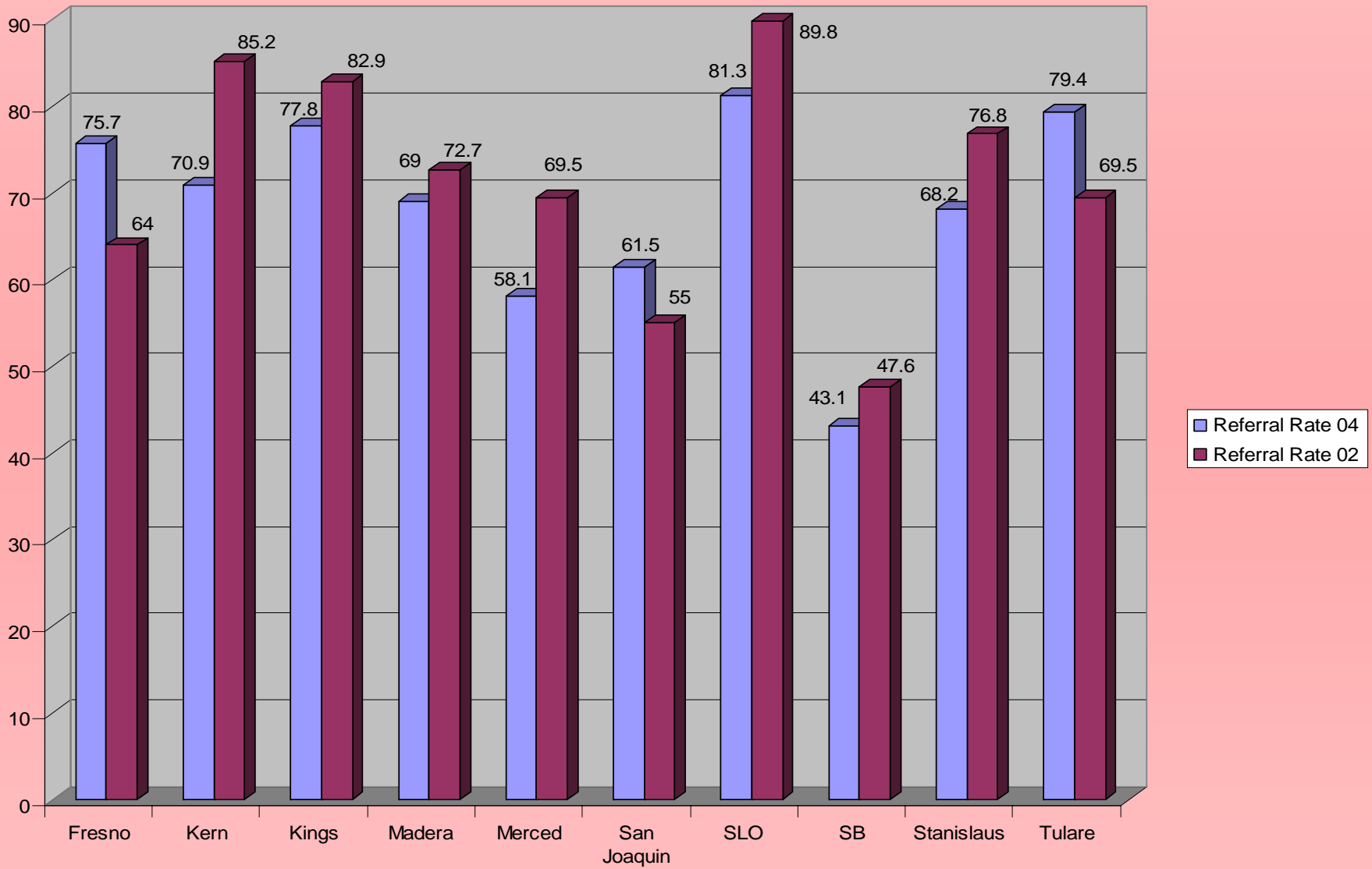

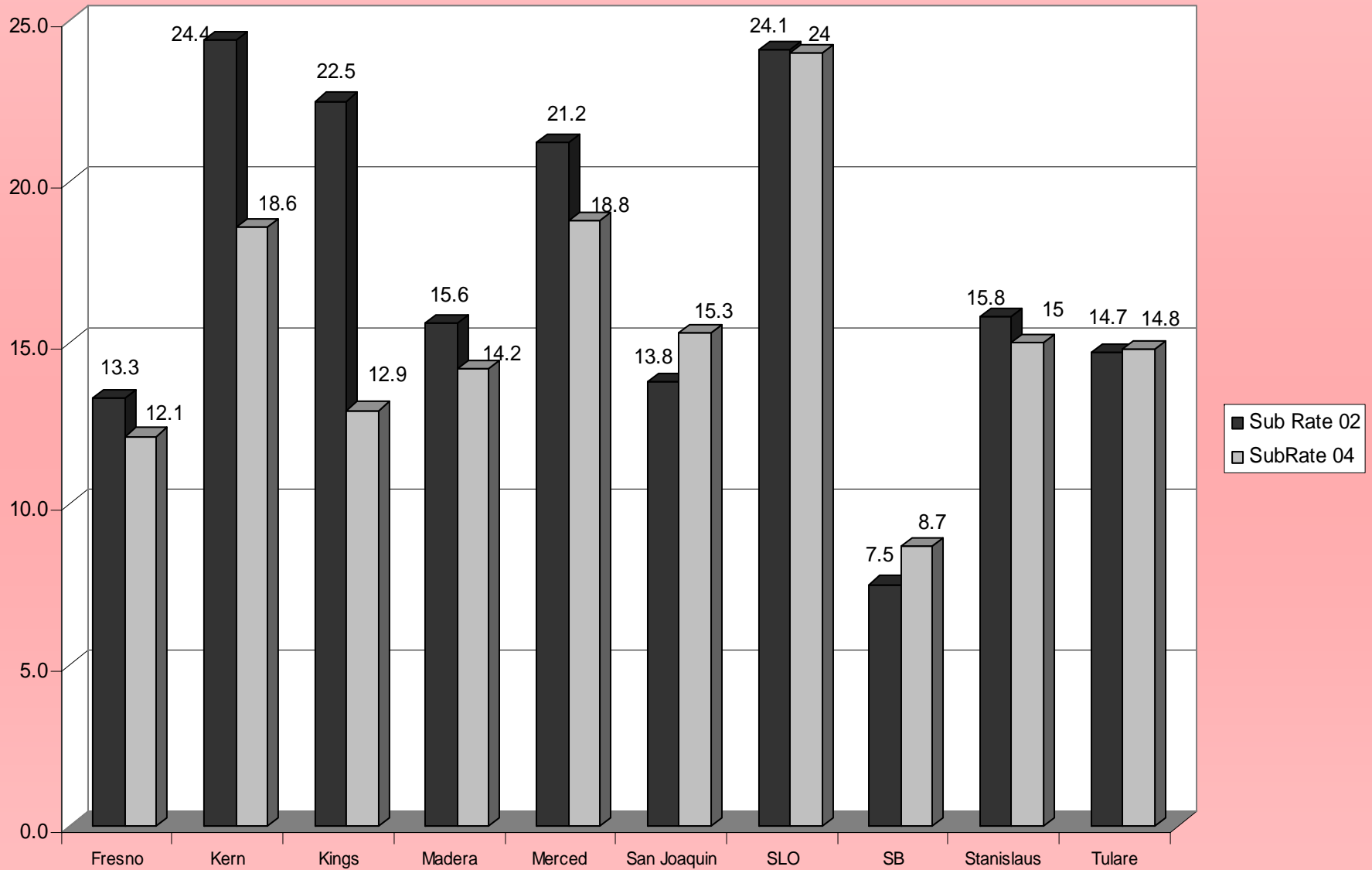

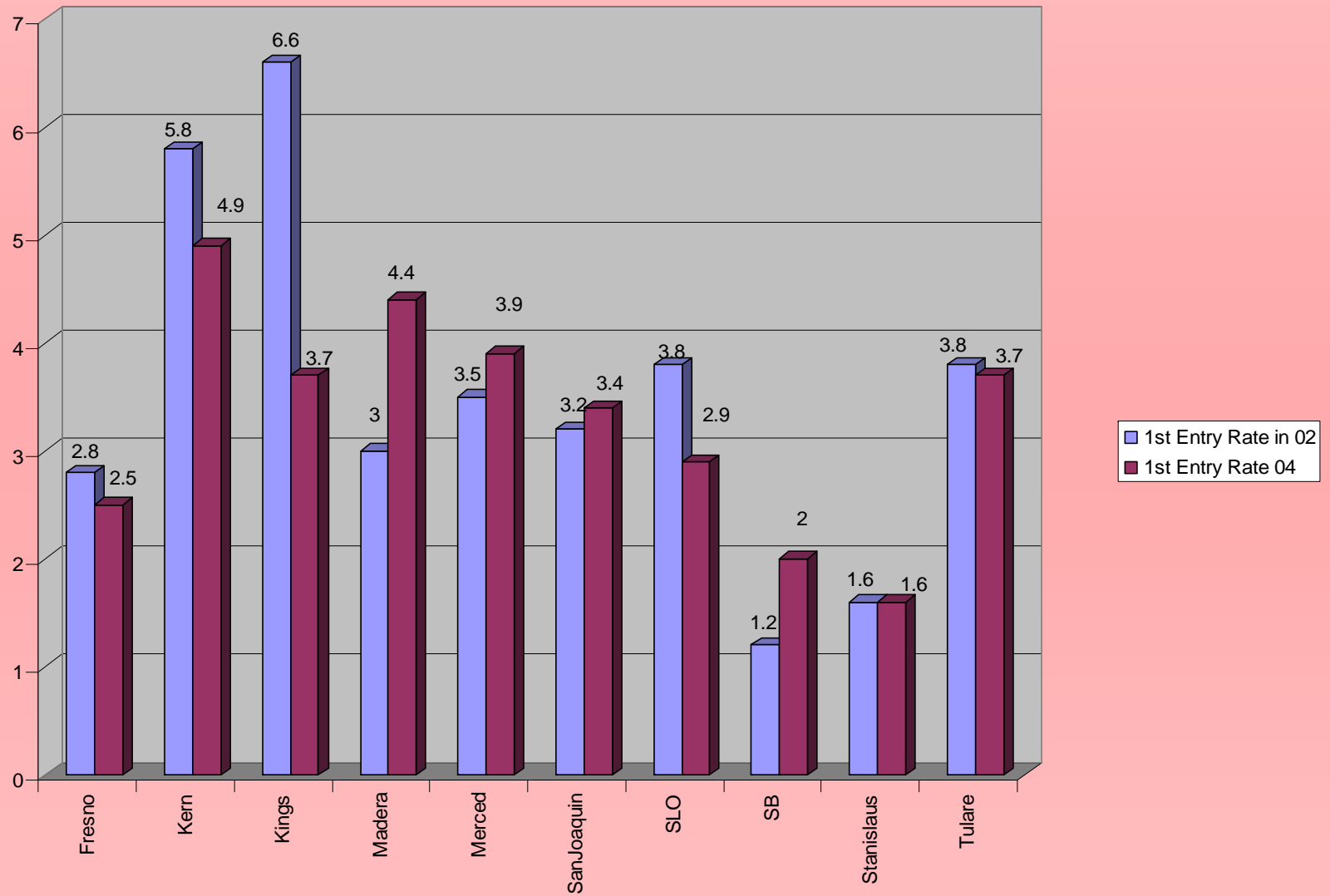
Referral Rates per 1000 Children 2004 vs 2002



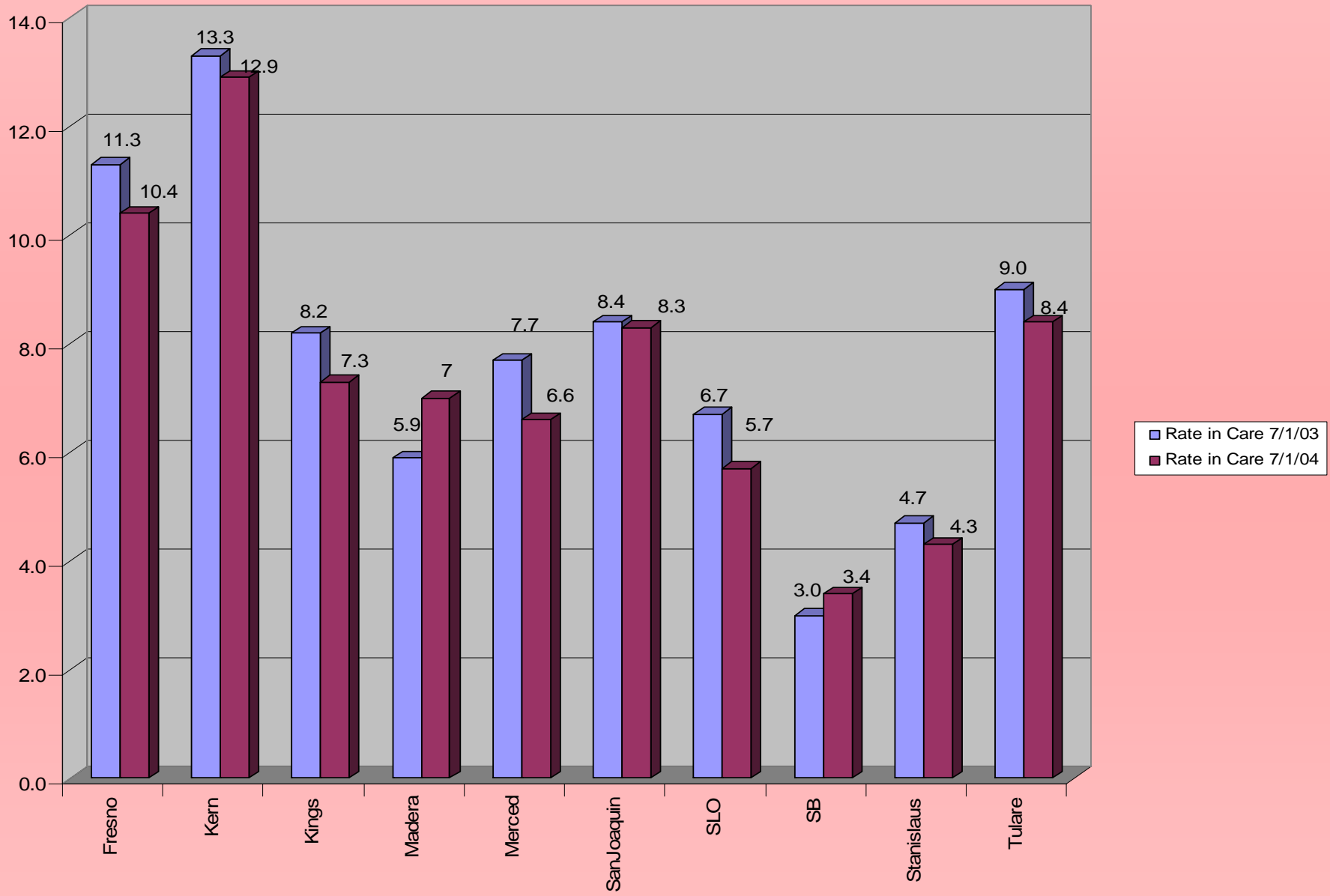
Substantiation Rate per 1000 Children 2002 vs 2004



First Entries into Foster Care Rate per 1000 Children - 2002 vs 2004



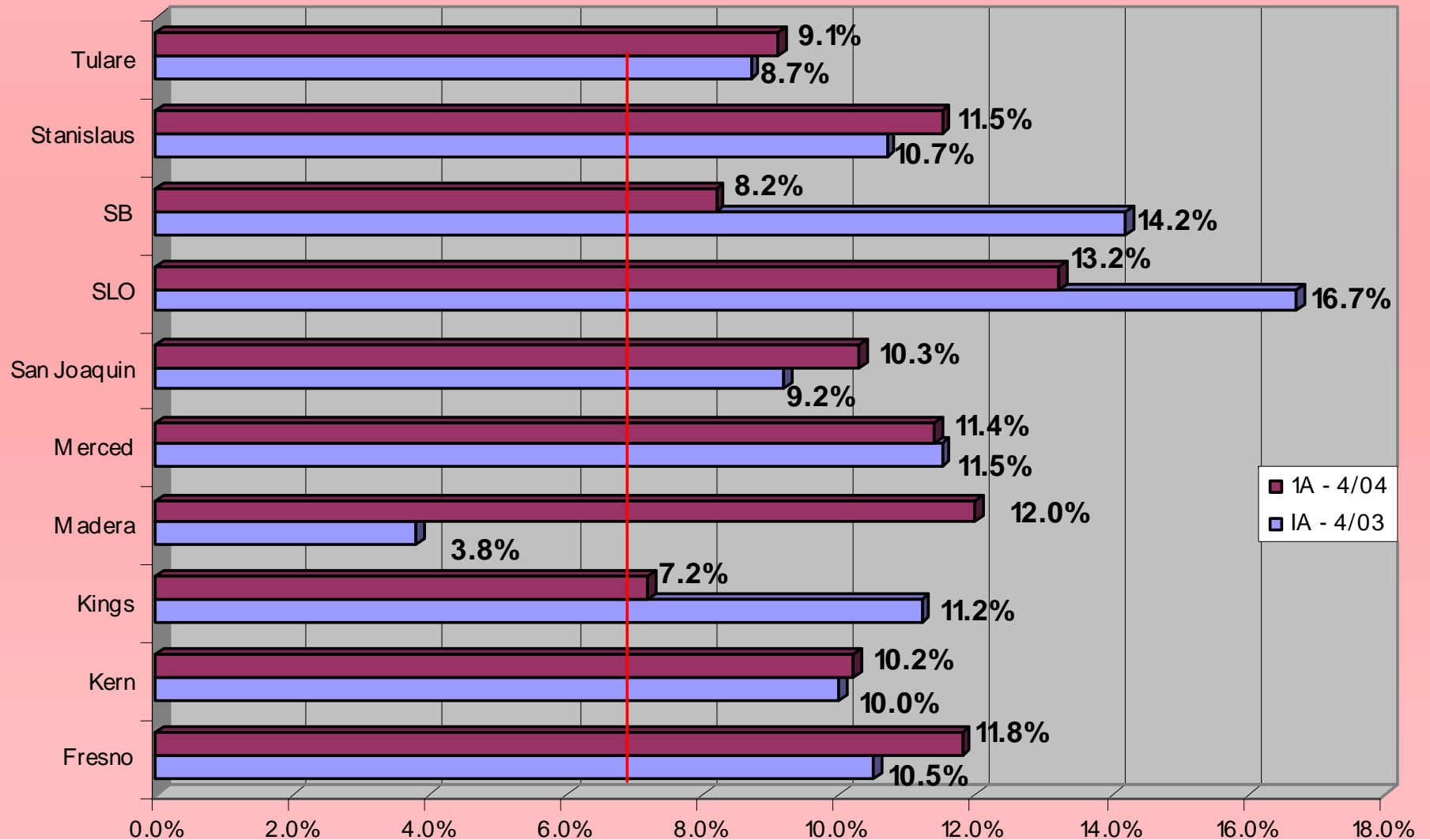
Rate in Care on 7/1/03 vs 7/1/04

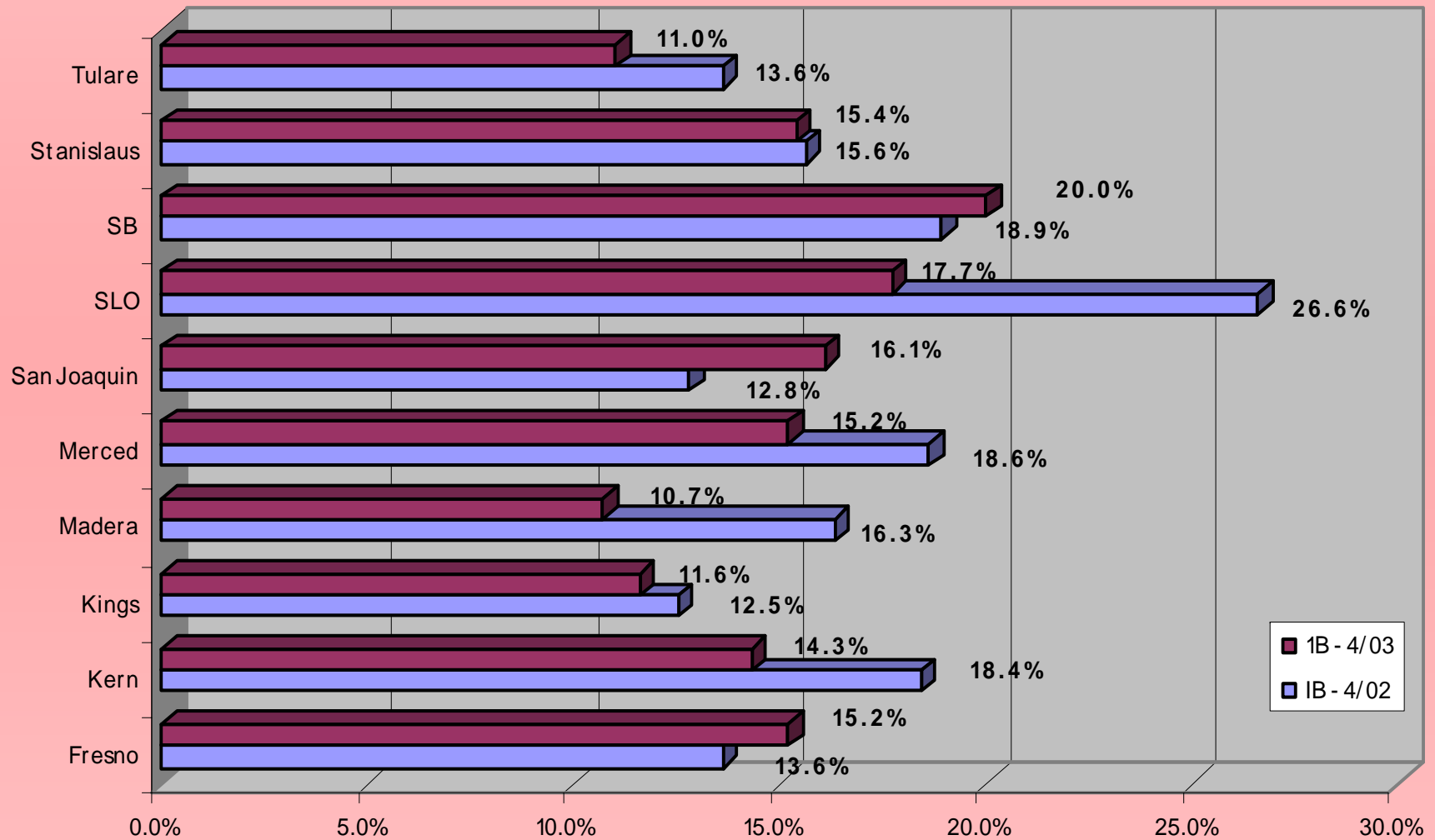

(4/1/04-3/31/05), what percent had another substantiated allegation within 6 mos.



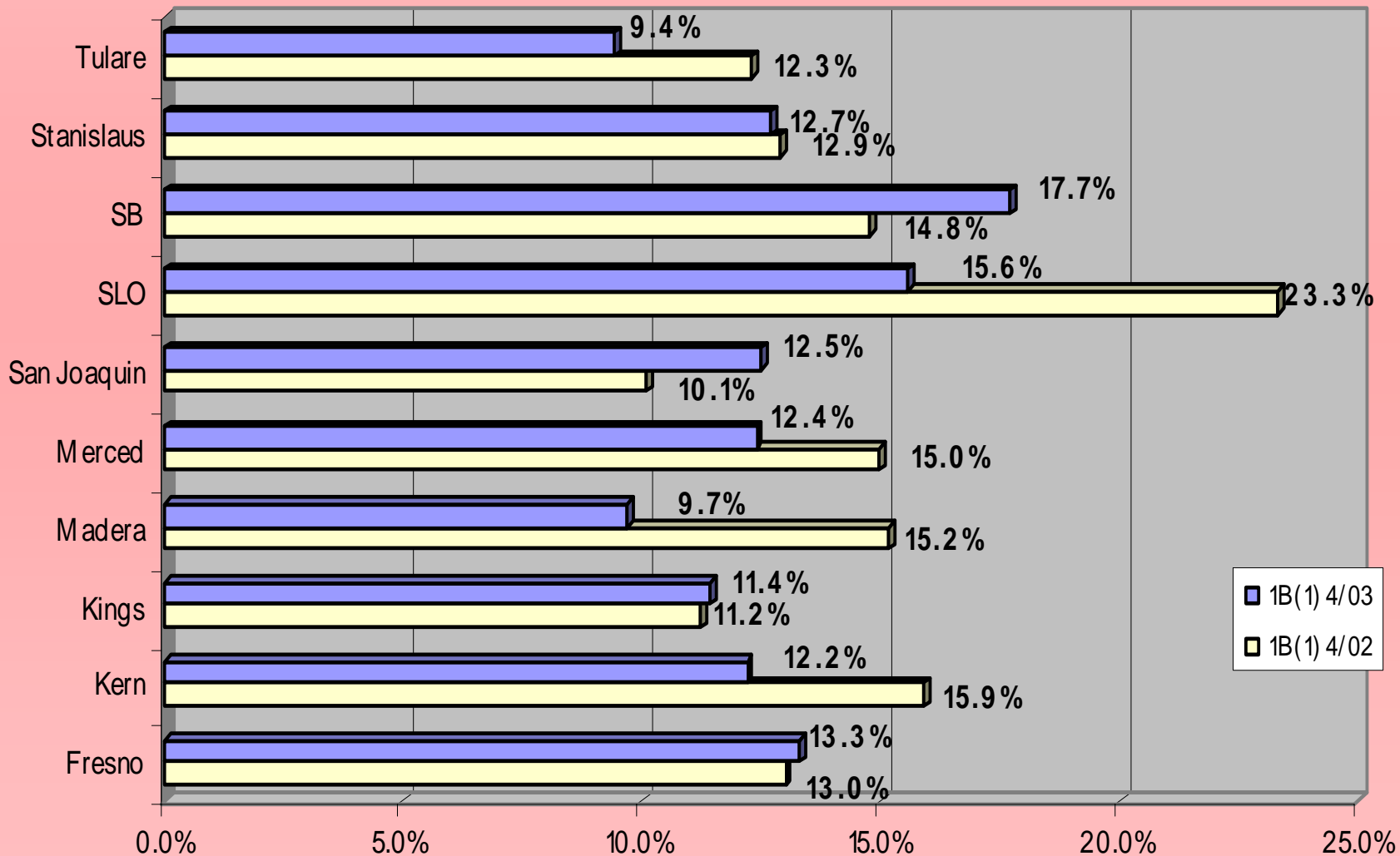
Recurrence of Maltreatment - 1B - State Measure

Of all children with a substantiated referral during the 12 month study period - (4/1/03-3/31/04), what percent had a subsequent referral within 12 mos?

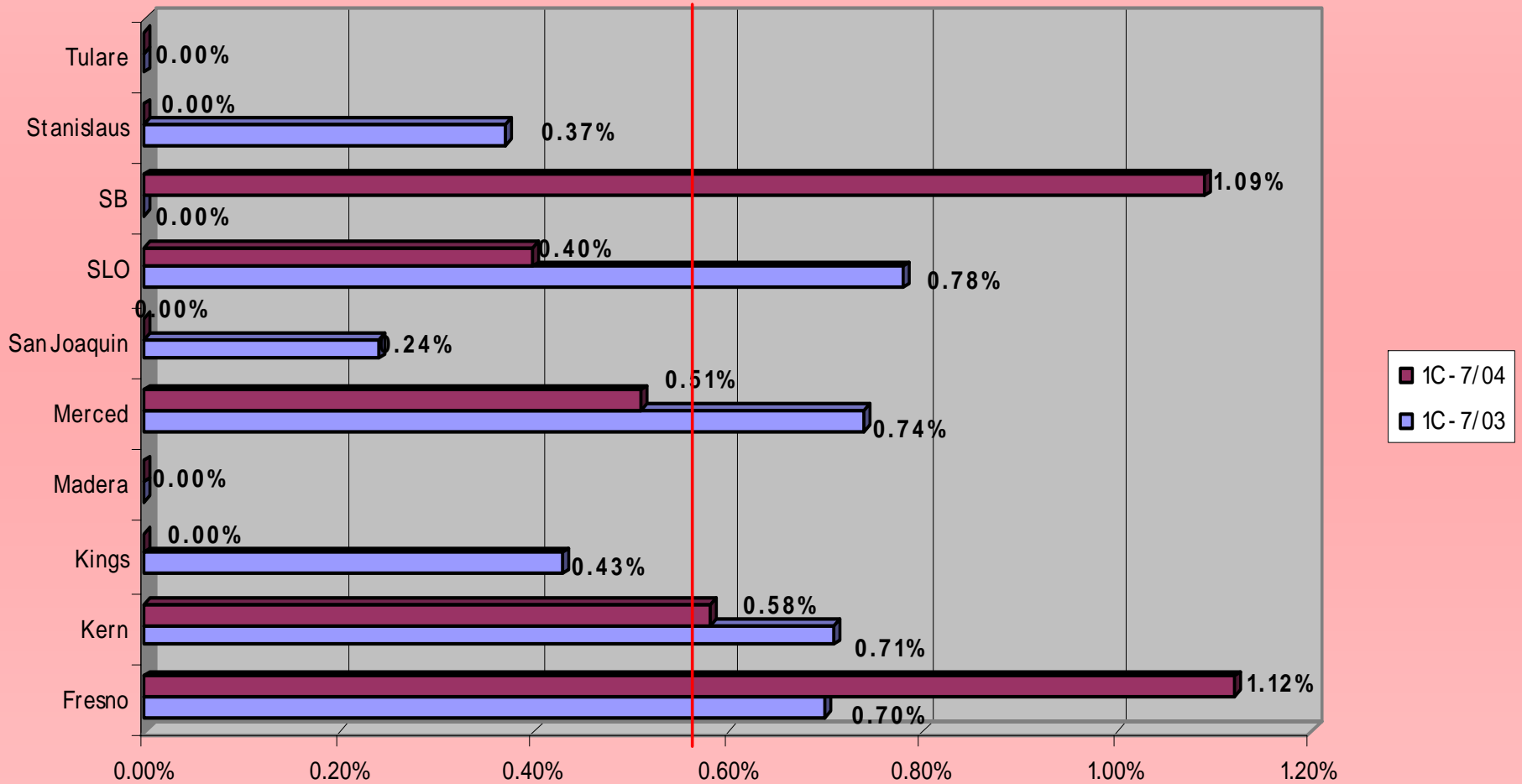

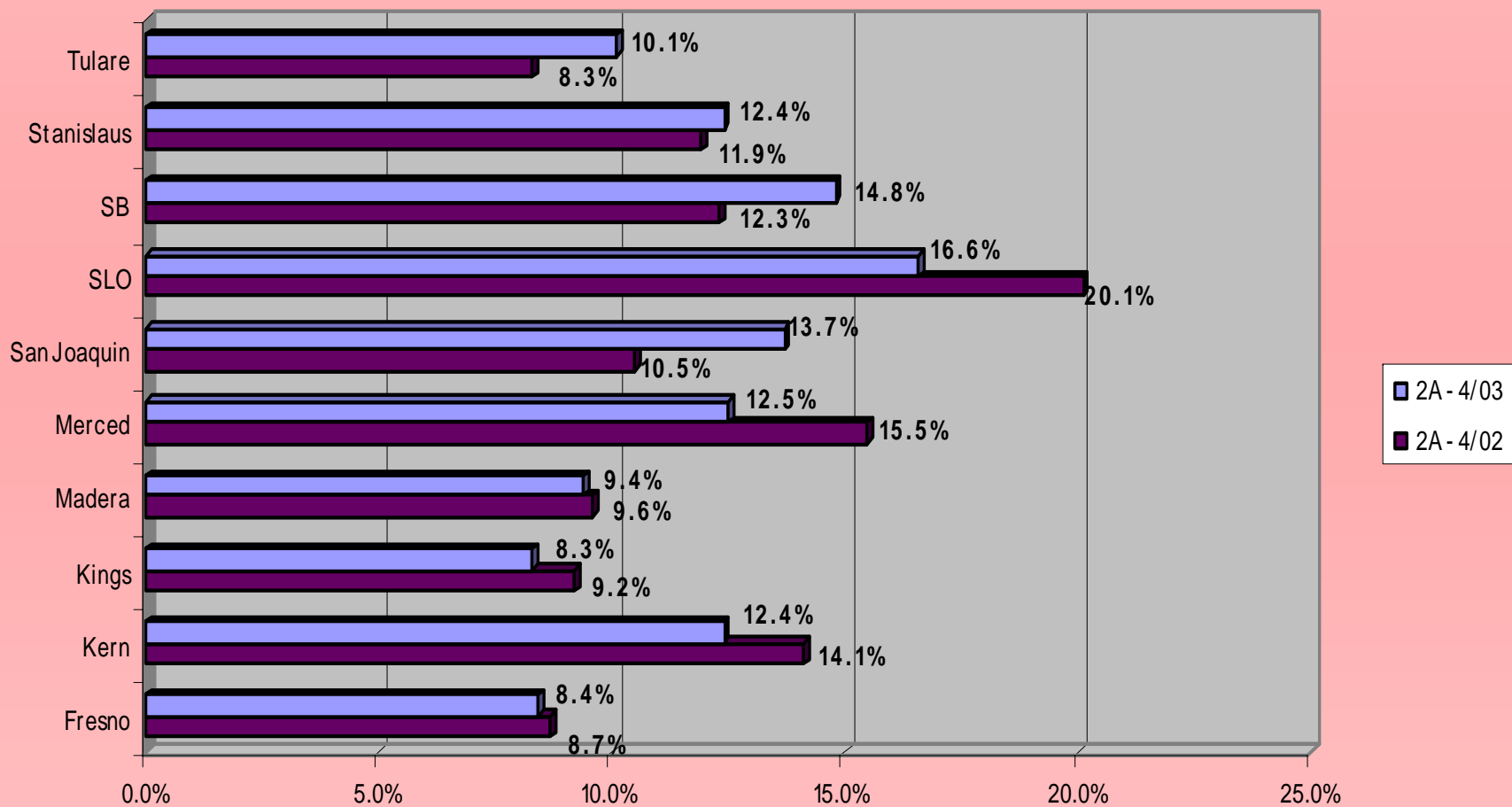
Of all children with a *First* substantiated referral during the 12 month study period -(4/1/03-3/31/04), what percent had a subsequent referral within 12 mos?



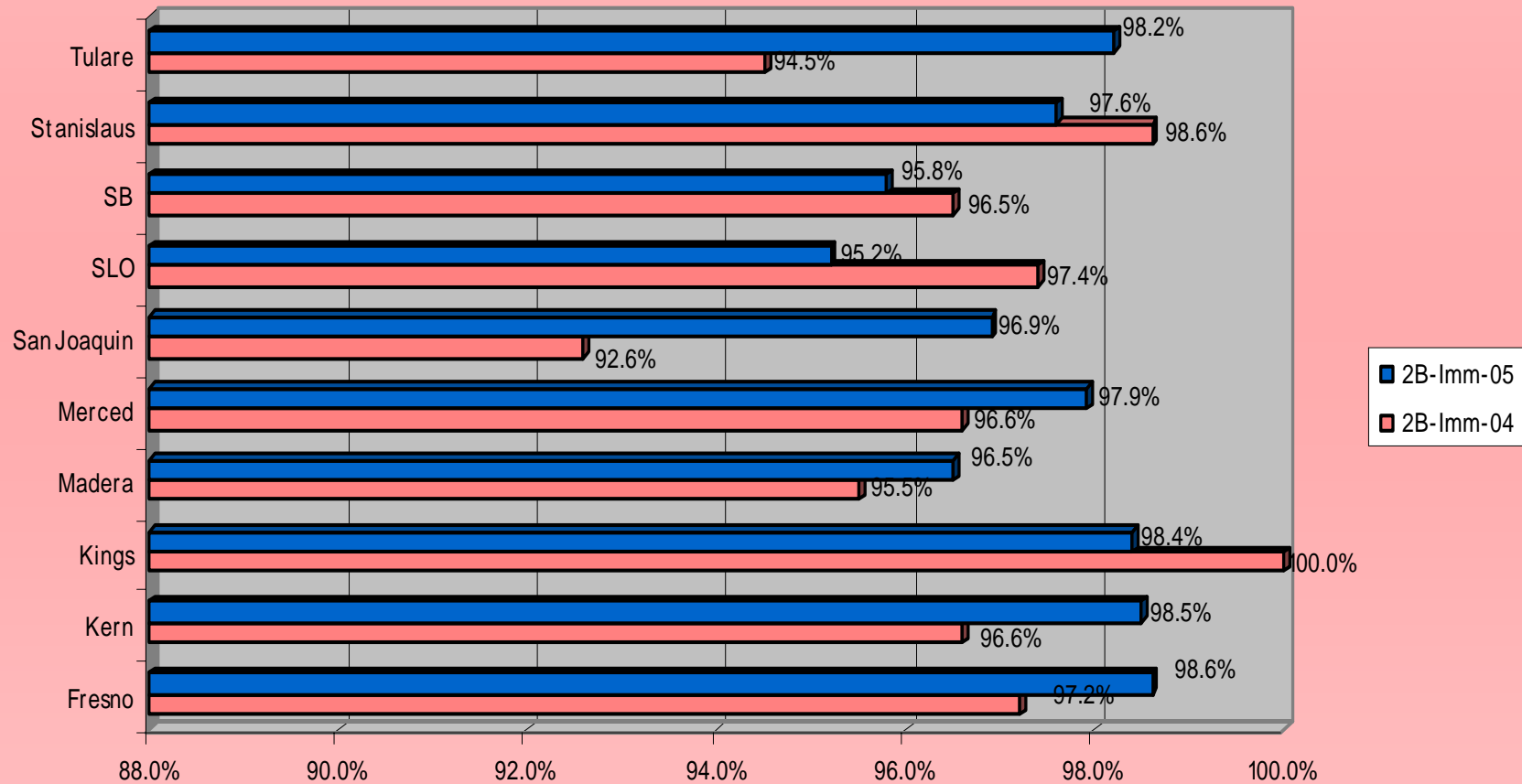
1C - Rate of Child Abuse/Neglect in Foster Care - Federal Measure 7/1/04-3/31/05



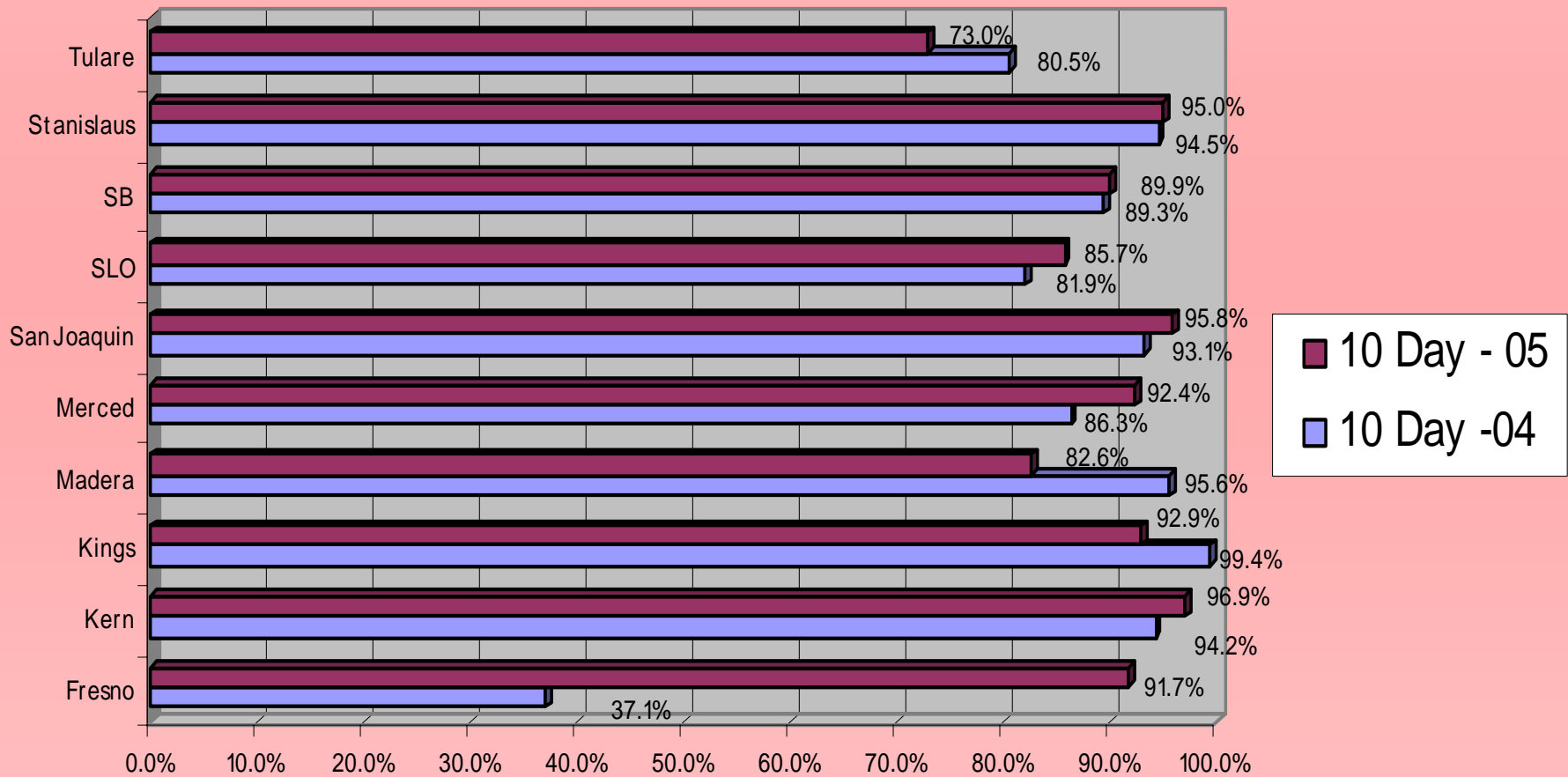
**Rate of Recurrence of Abuse/Neglect in Homes

2A - State Measure - Cohort Year 4/1/03 - 3/31/04**



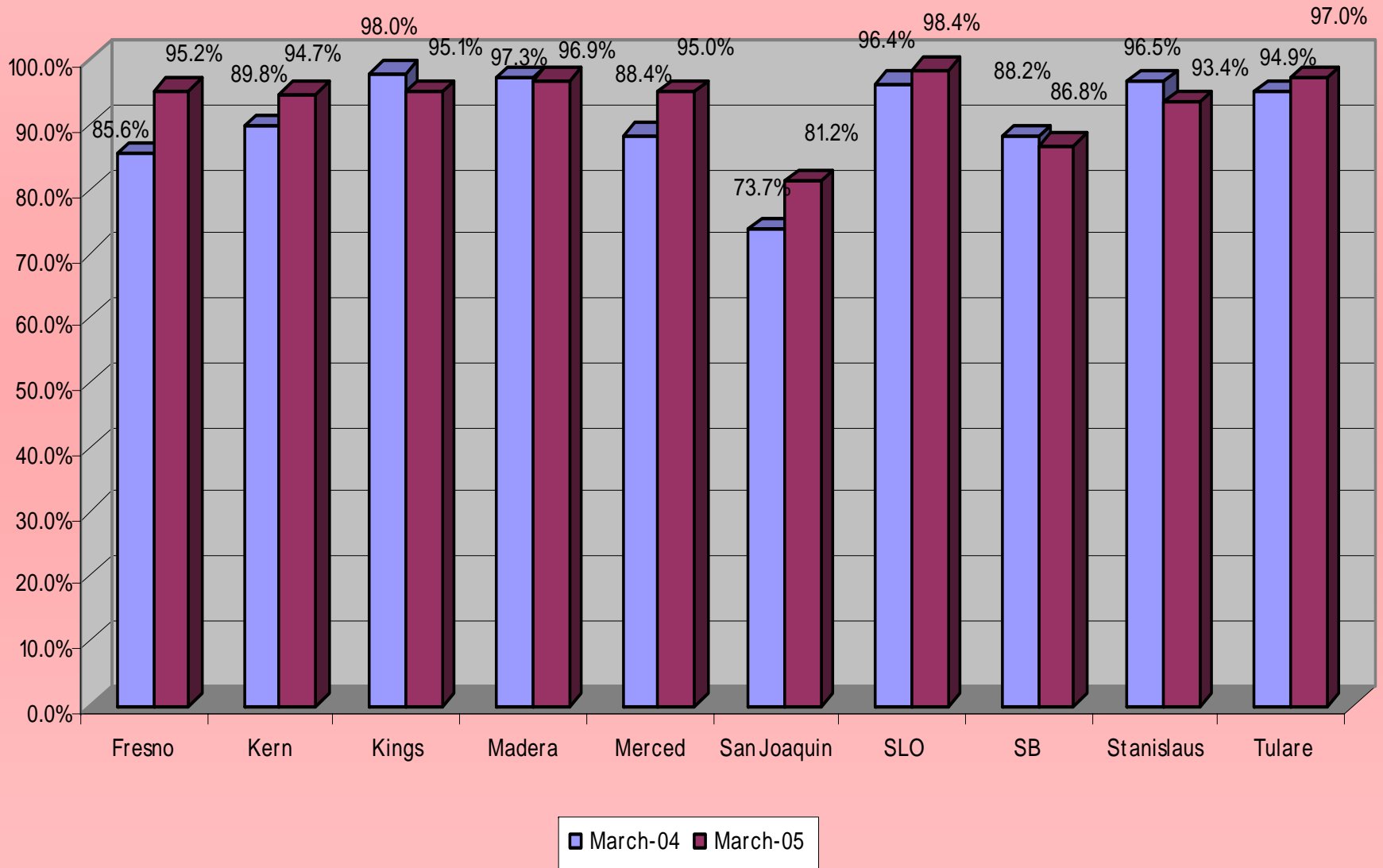
Percent of Child Abuse/Neglect Referrals with a Timely Response

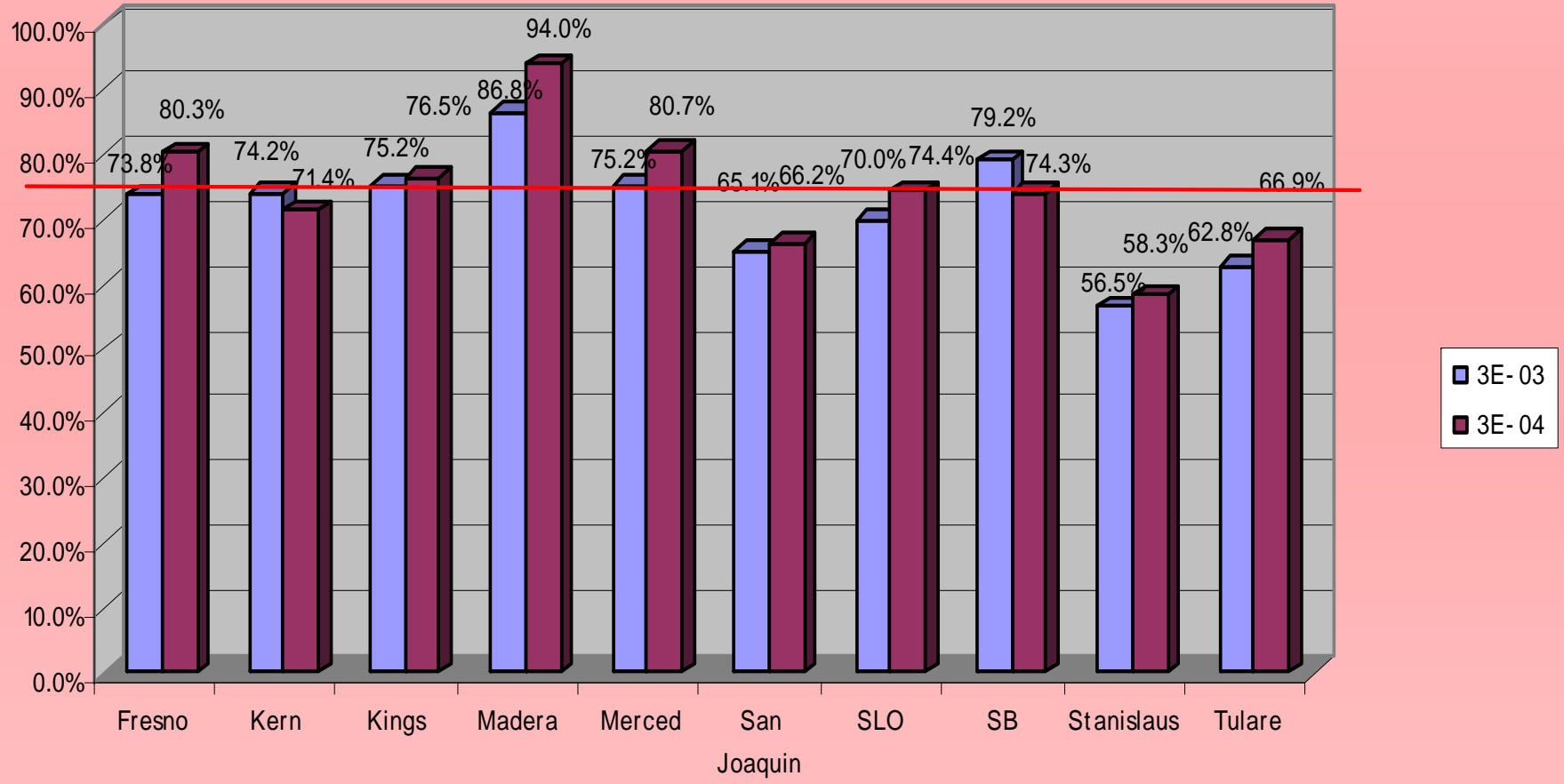
Timely Social Worker Visits With Child - 2C State Measure - March 2004 vs March 2005



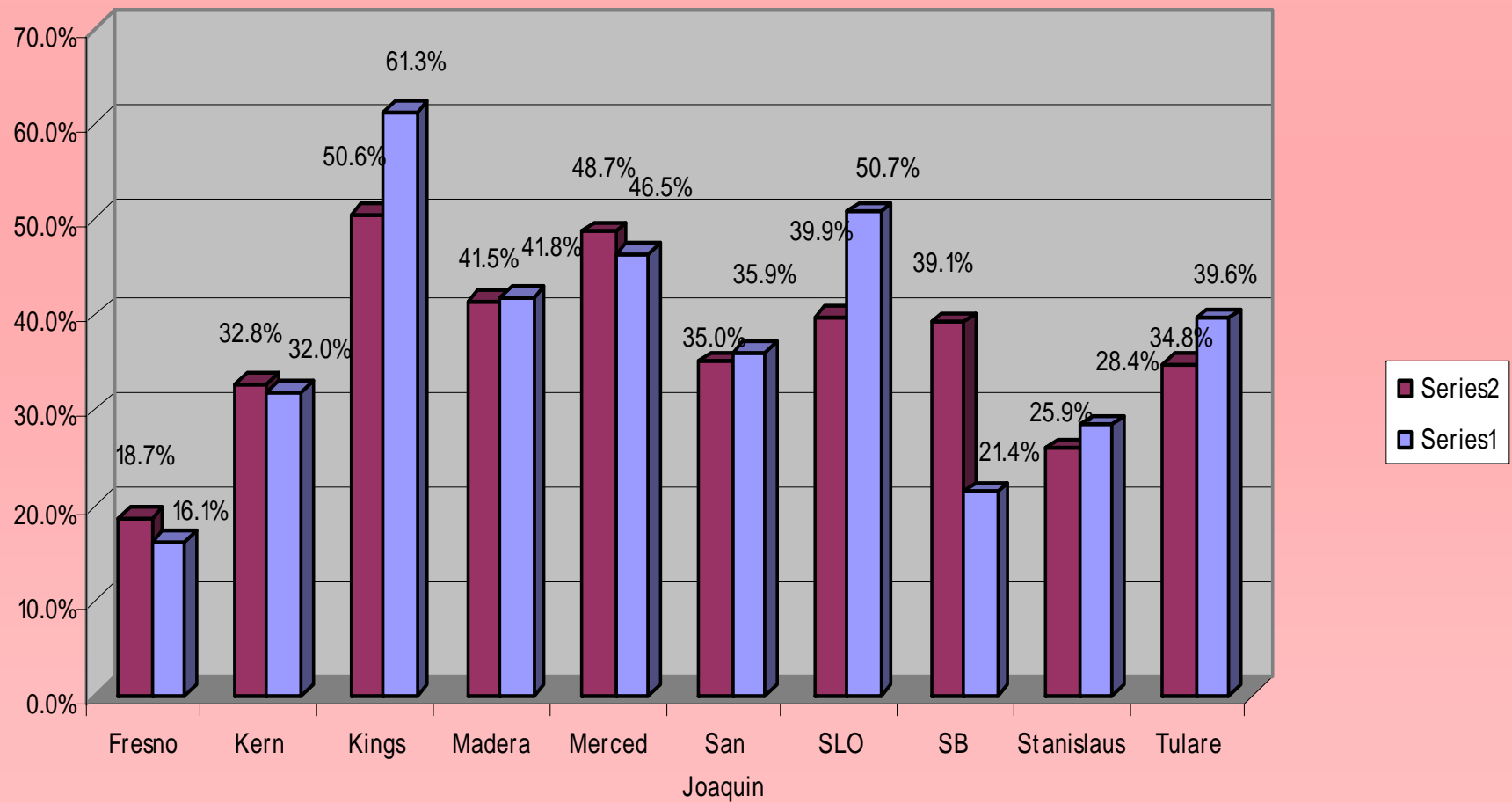

in care for less than 12 months.

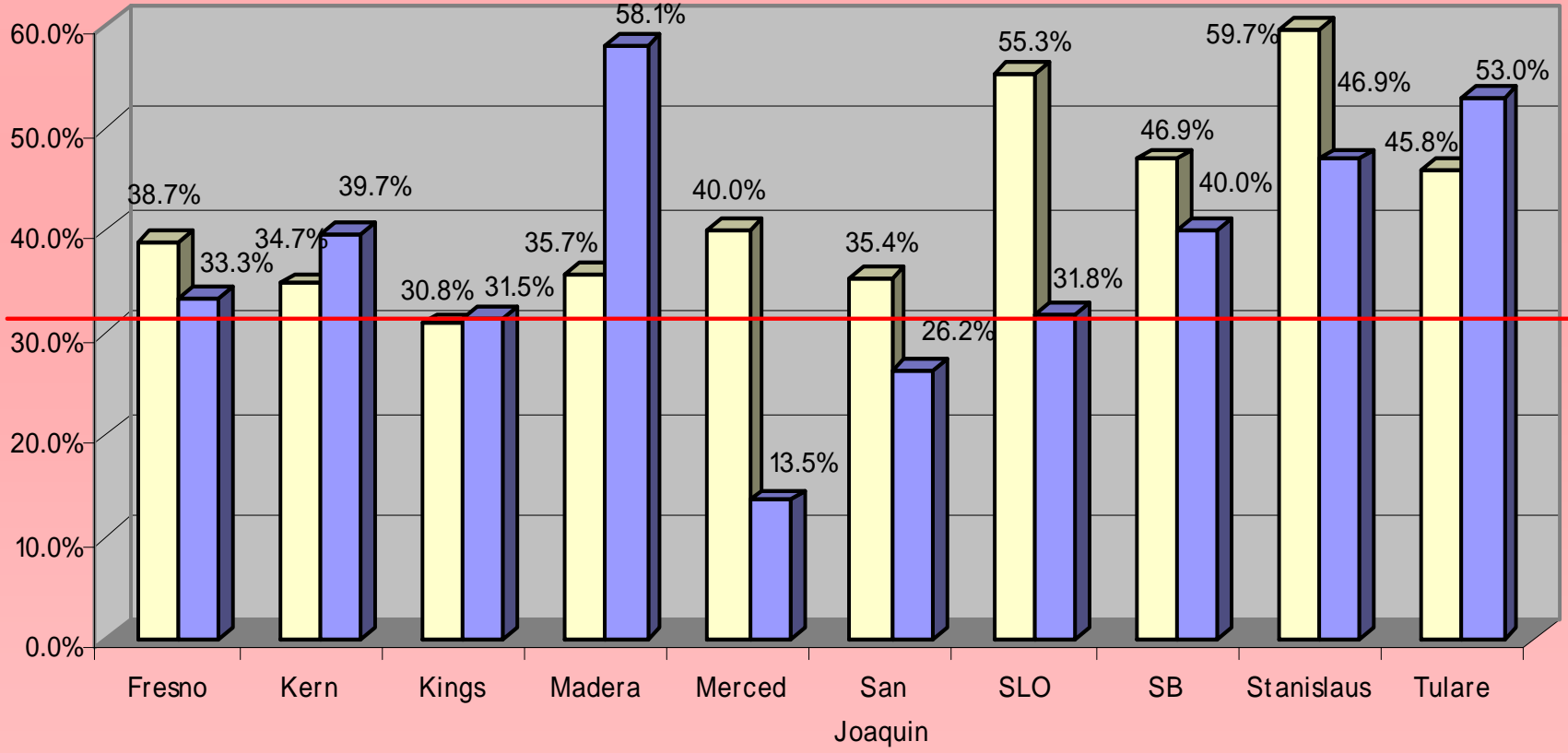


Length of Time to Exit FC to Reunification - 3A - State Measure

within 12 months.



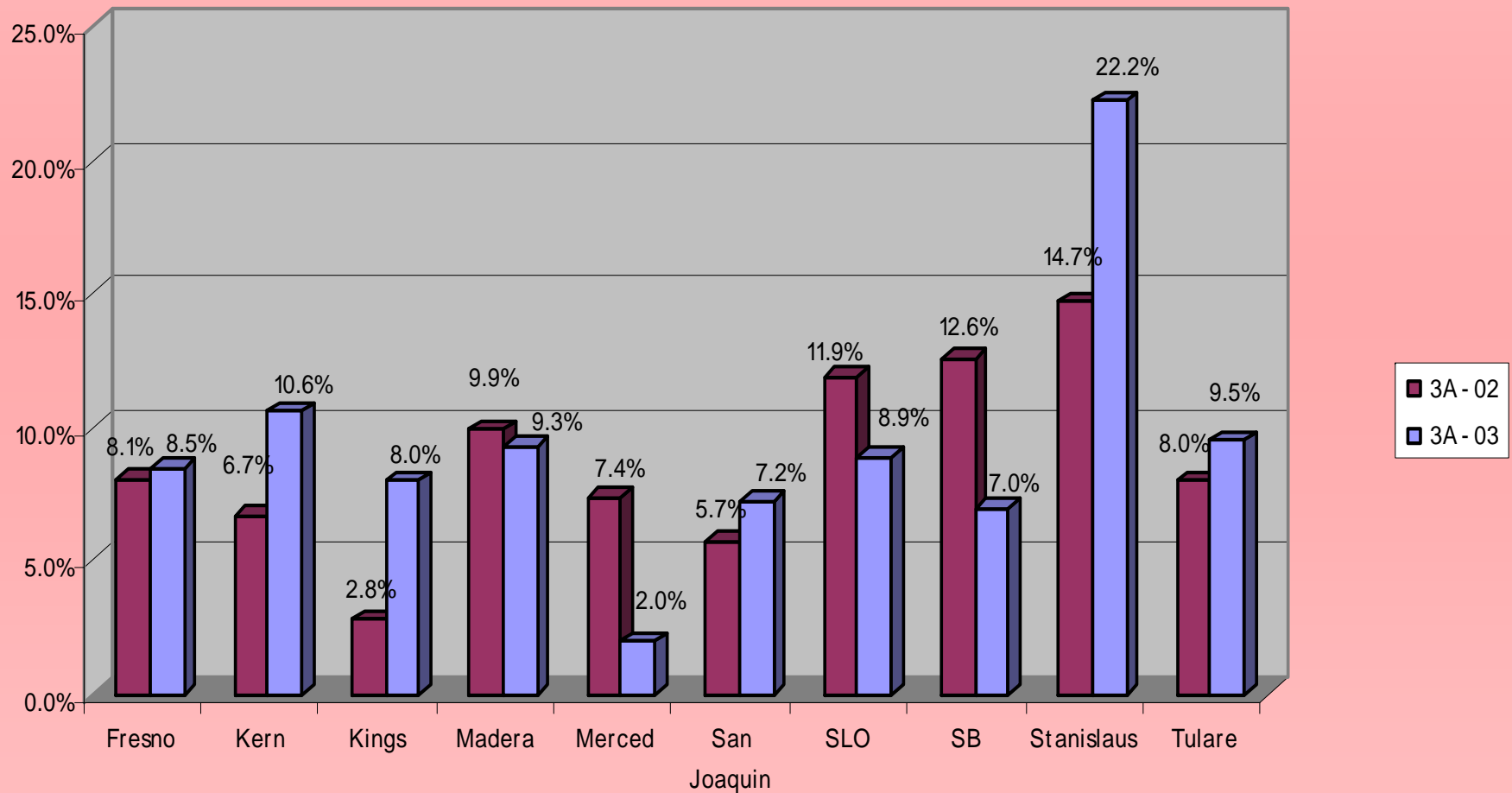
Length of Time to Exit FC to Adoption - 3D - Federal

Of children adopted during study period 4/1/04 - 3/31/05, this % had been in care for less than 24 months.



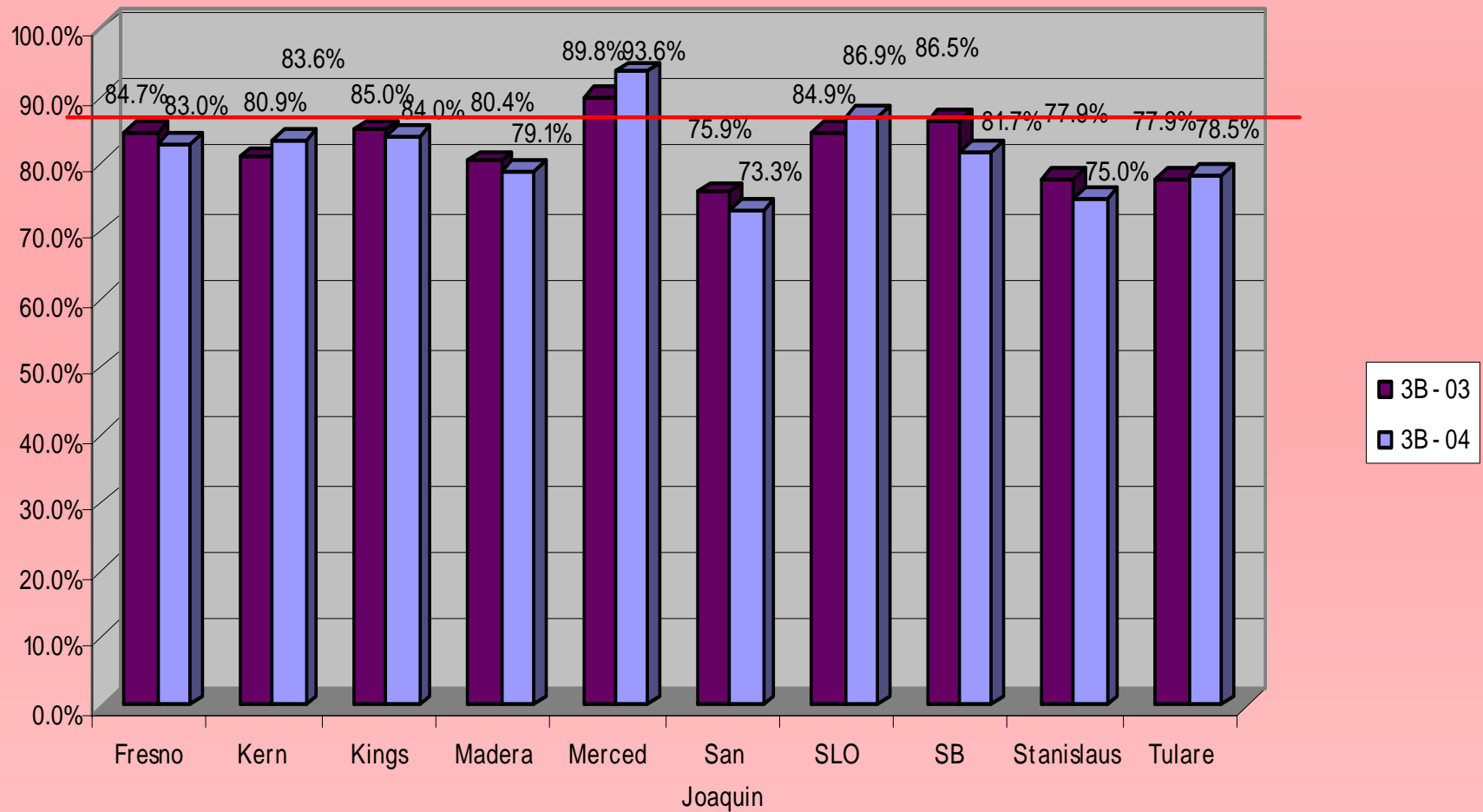
Length of Time to Exit FC to Adoption - 3A - State

Children entering FC for first time during 4/1/02- 3/31/03, the % adopted within 24 months.



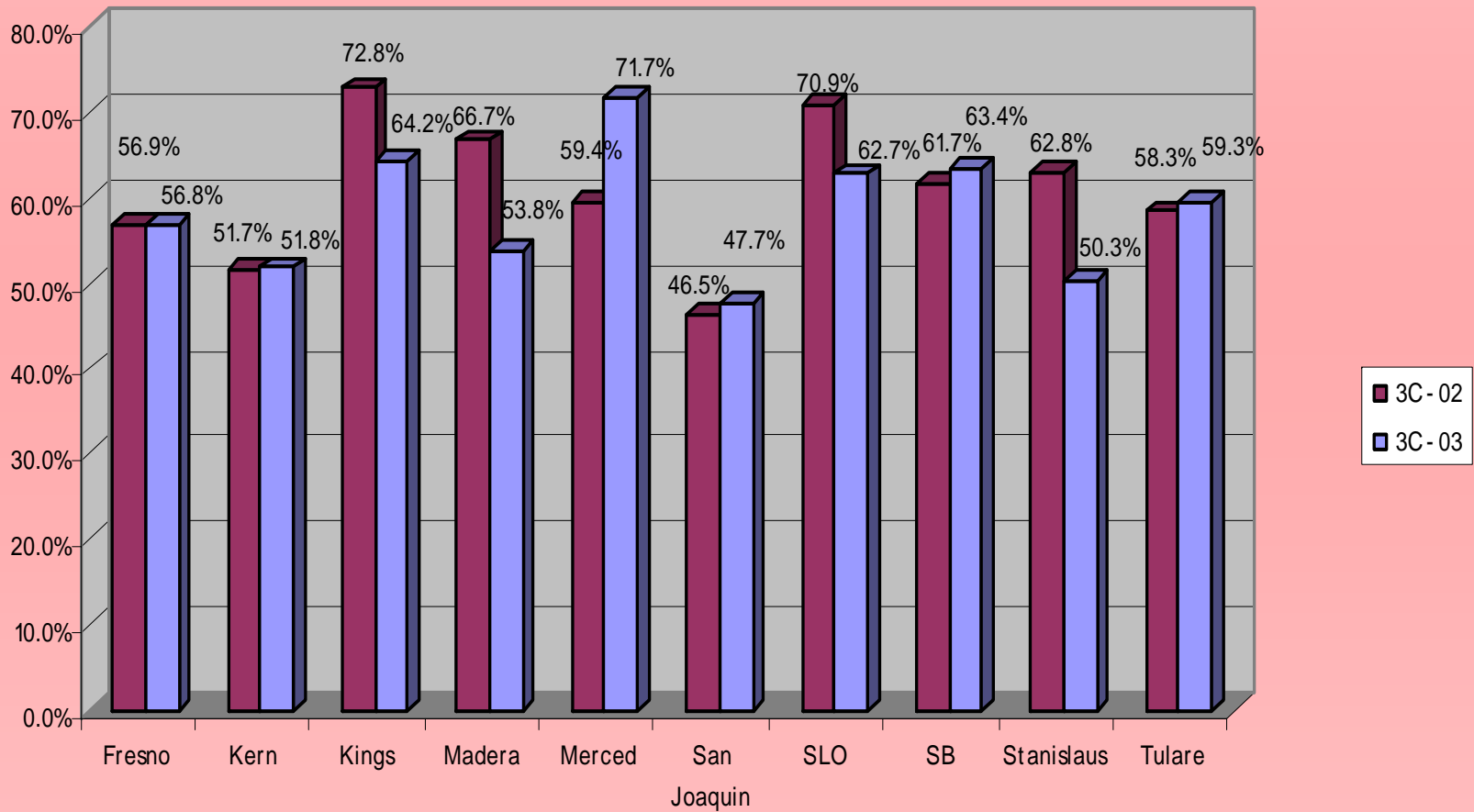
Multiple Placements - 3B - Federal Measure

Children in FC less than 12 months during study period 4/1/04 - 3/31/05, the % that had no more than 2 placements.



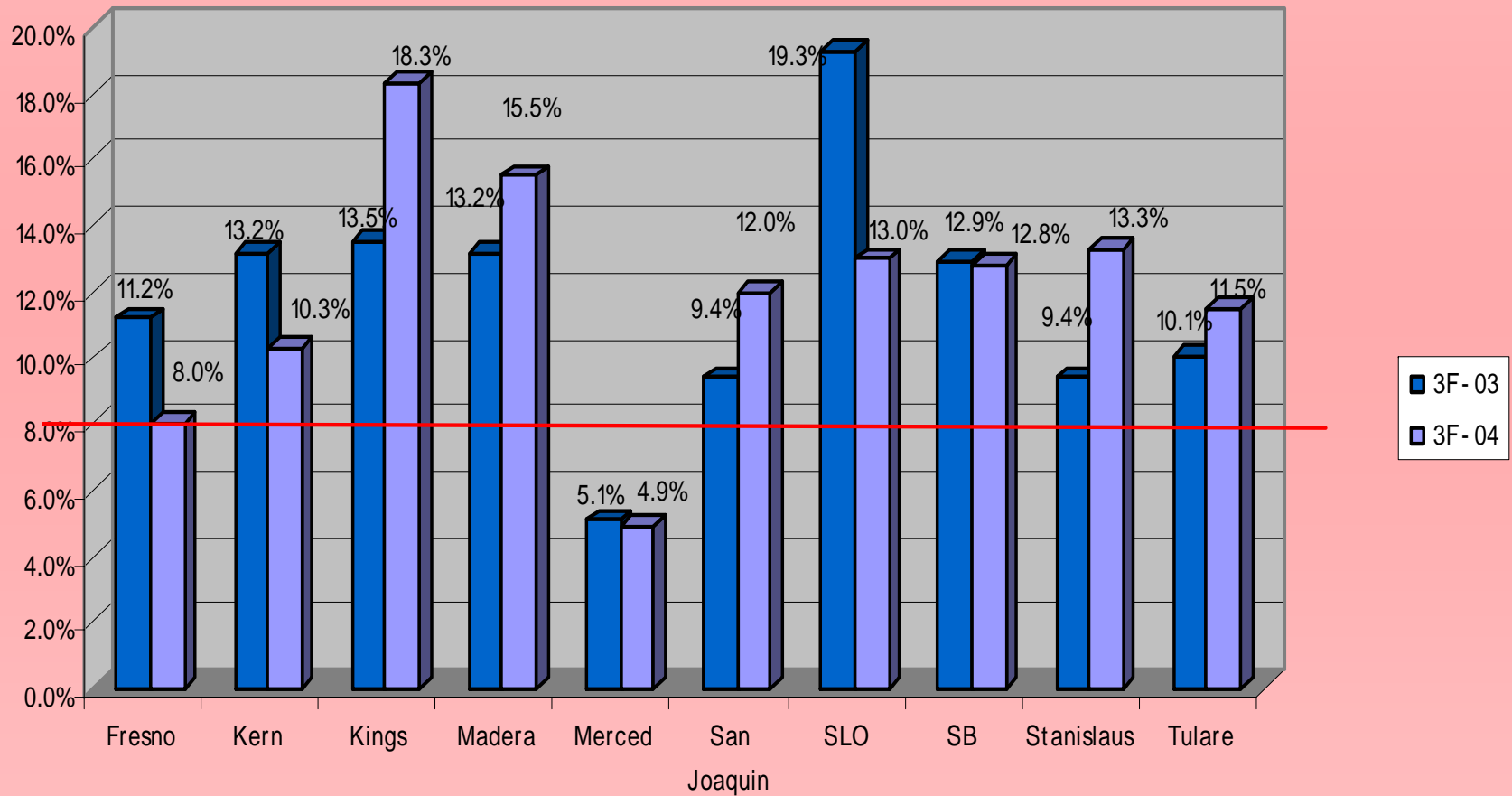
Multiple Placements - 3C -State Measure

Children entering FC for the first time during 4/1/03 - 3/31/04, and were in care for 12 months, the % that had no more than 2 placements.



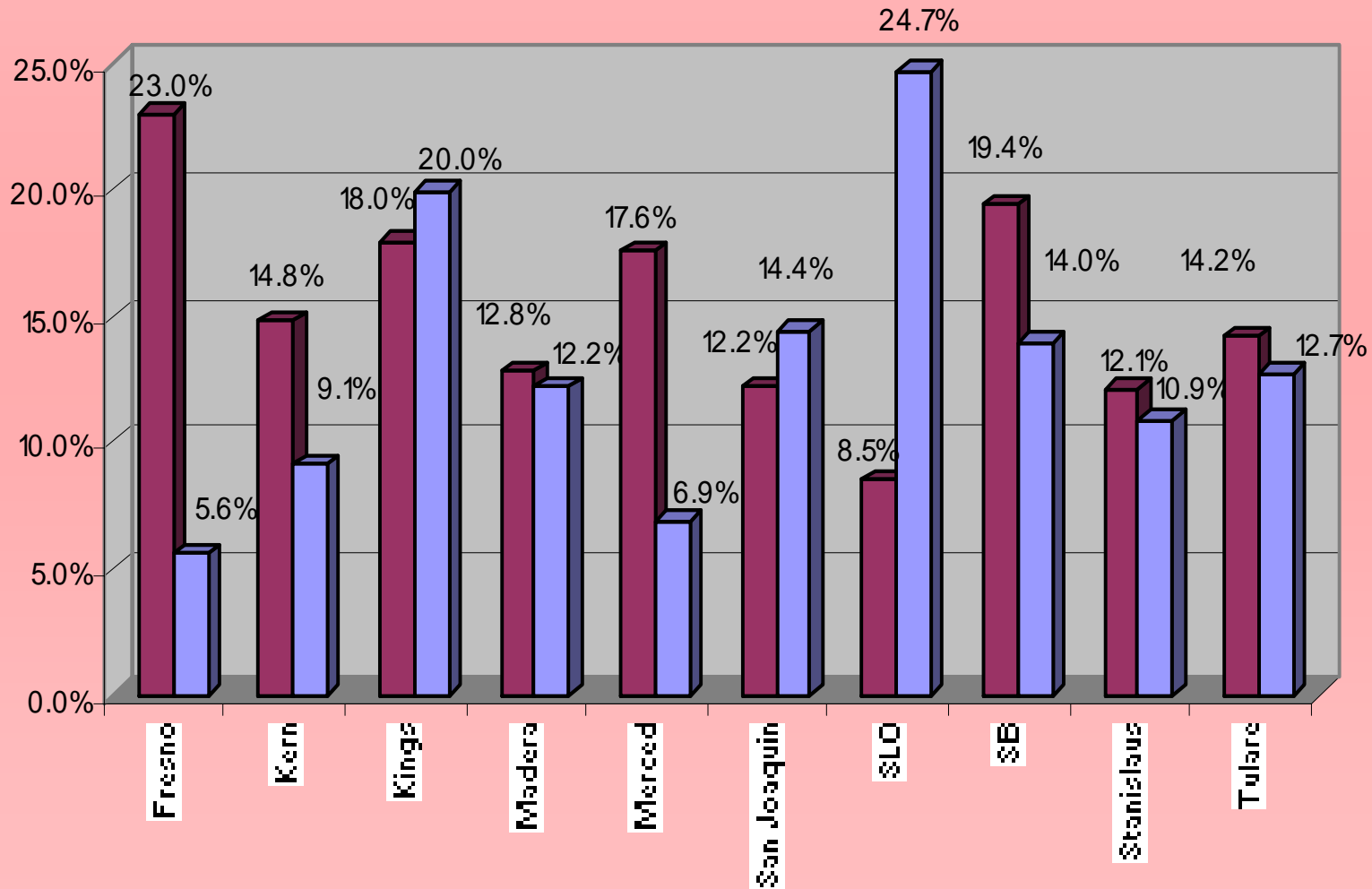
Rate of Re-entry - 3F - Federal Measure

Rate of Re-entry - 3G - State Measure

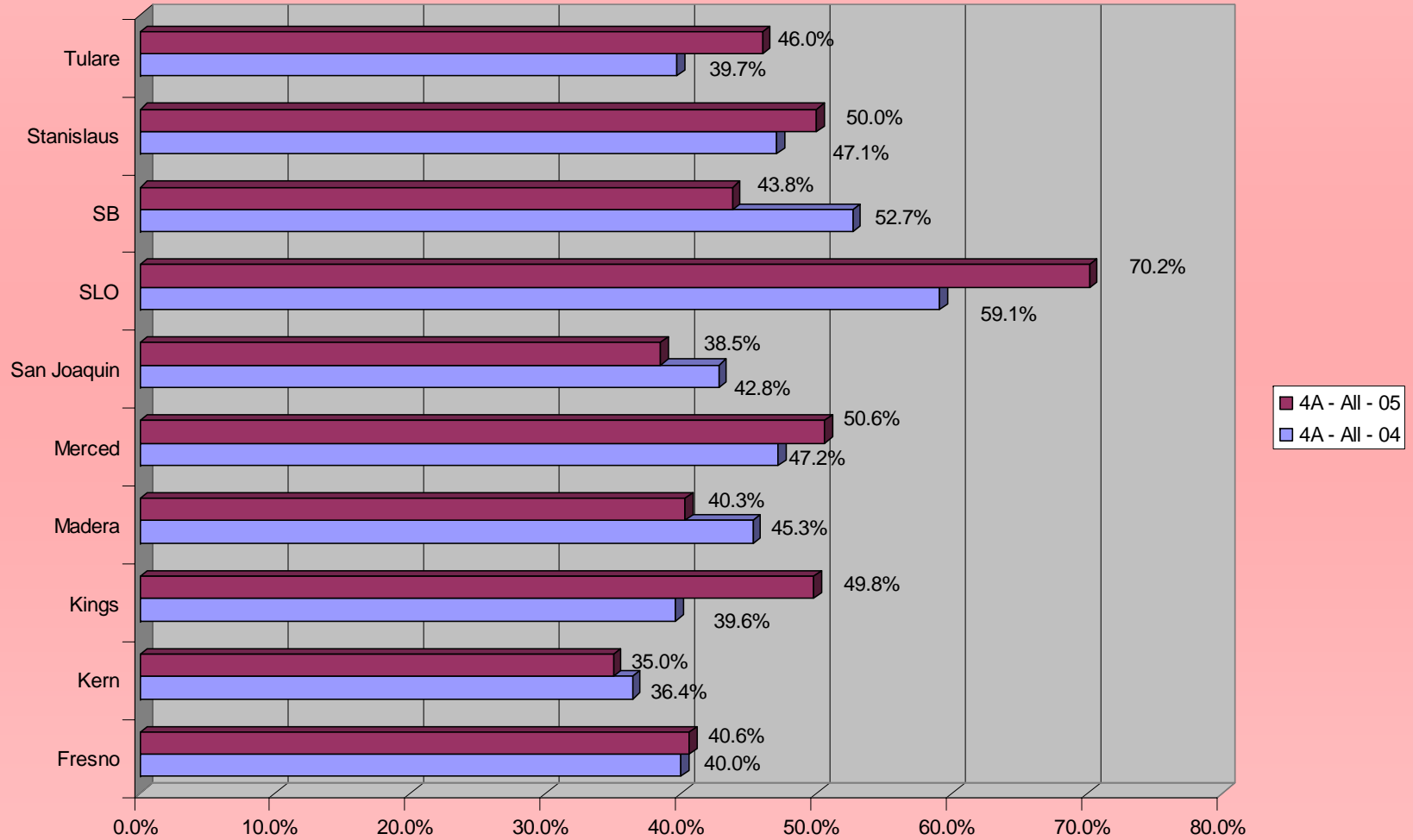
Children entering FC for the first time during 4/1/02 - 3/31/03, and were in care for 12 months, the % that re-entered FC within 12 months of reunification.

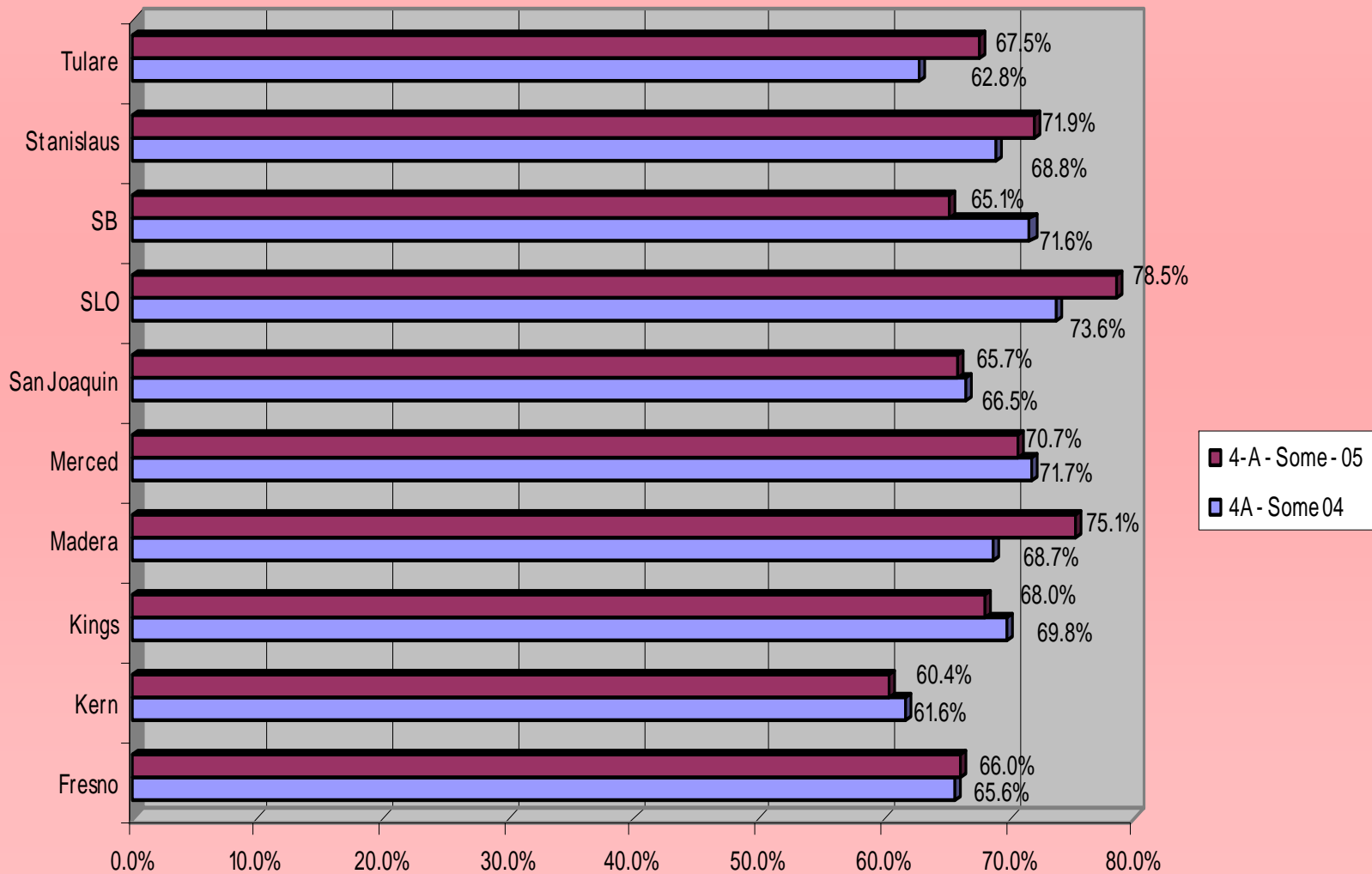

(Point in Time), the % placed with all of their siblings.**



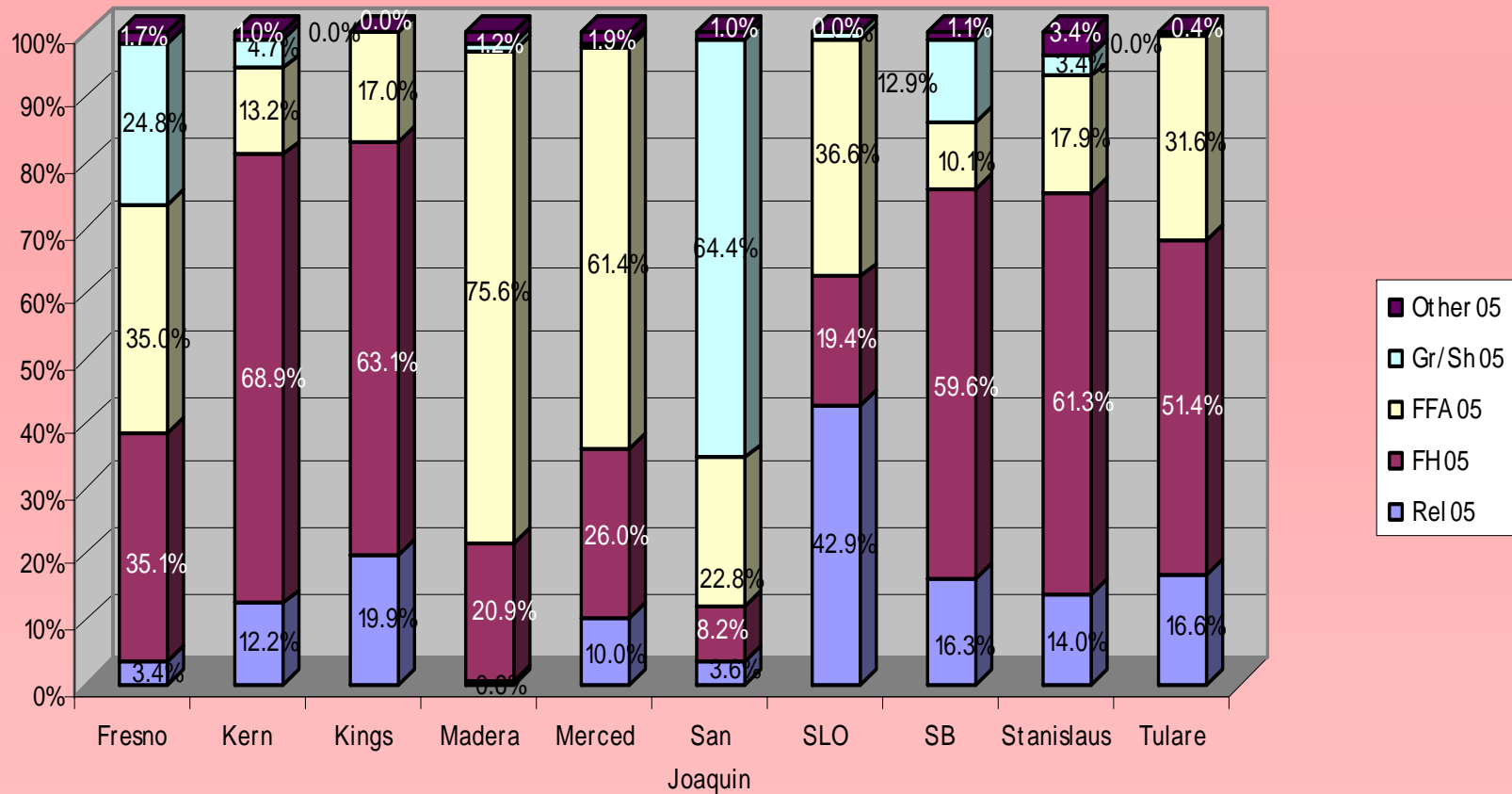
Siblings Placed Together in Foster Care - 4A State Measure

Initial Placement**

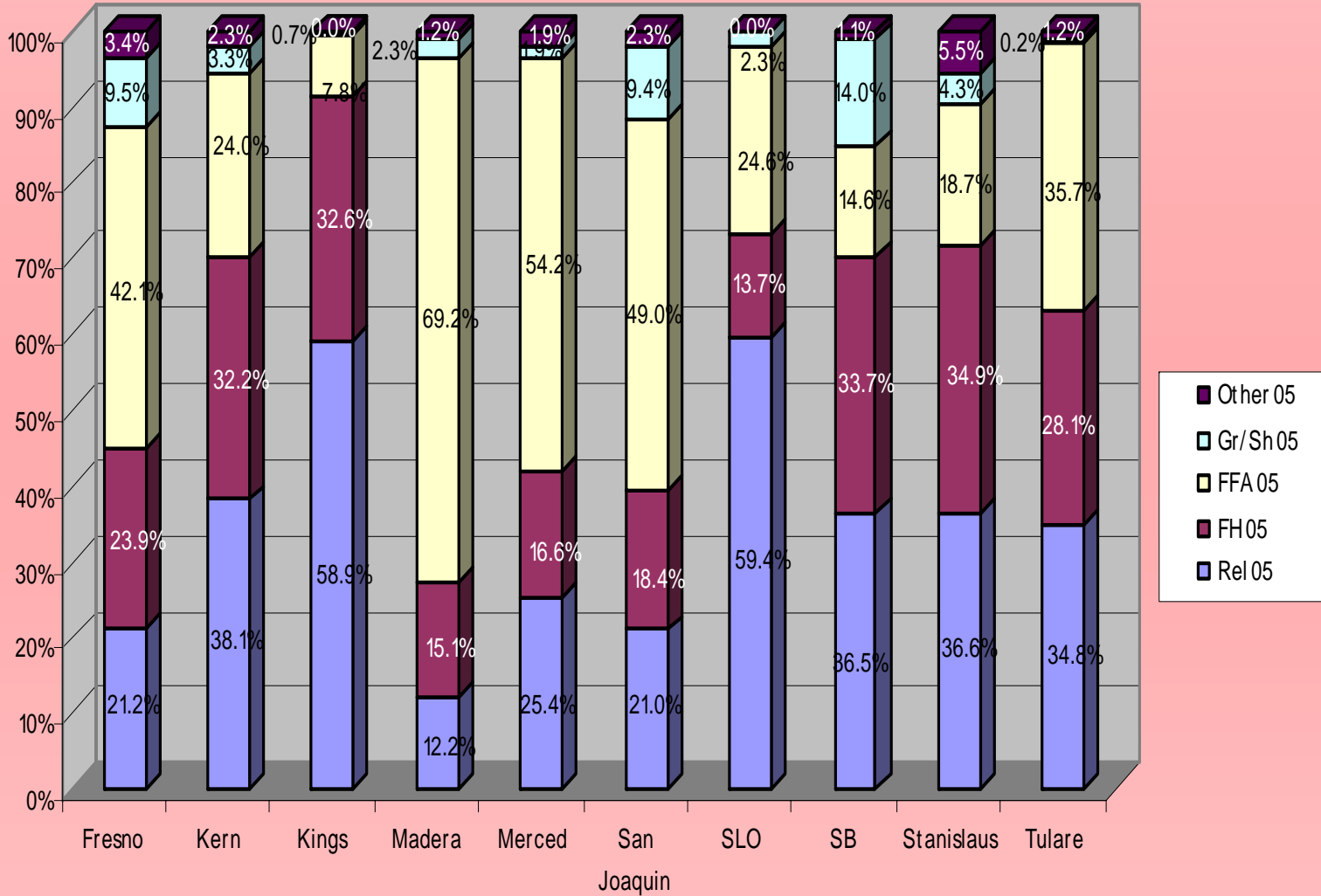
**Children entering FC for the first time - 4/1/04 - 3/31/05
The first placement type.**



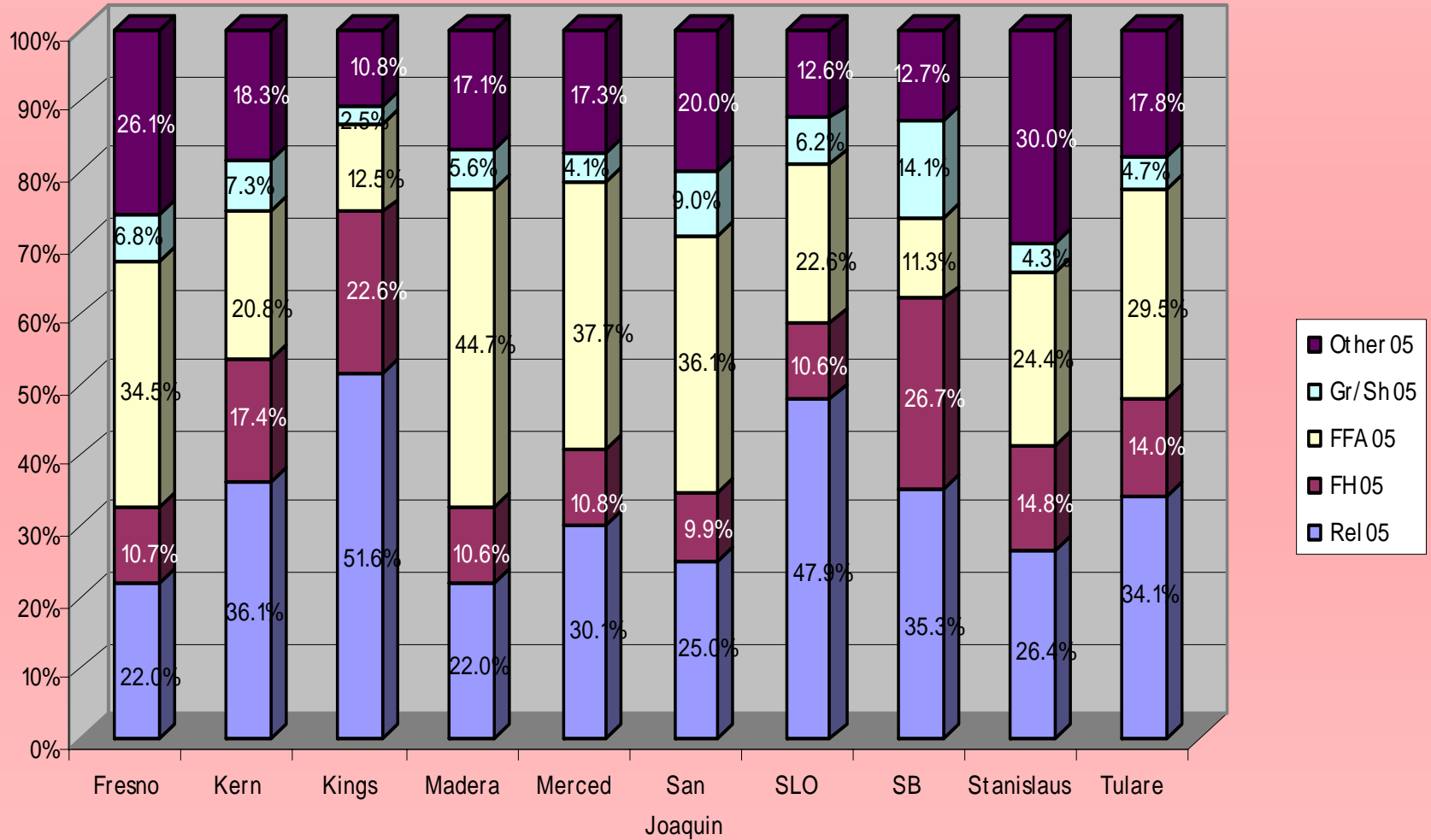
FC Placement in Least Restrictive Settings - 4B - State Measure

Primary Placement

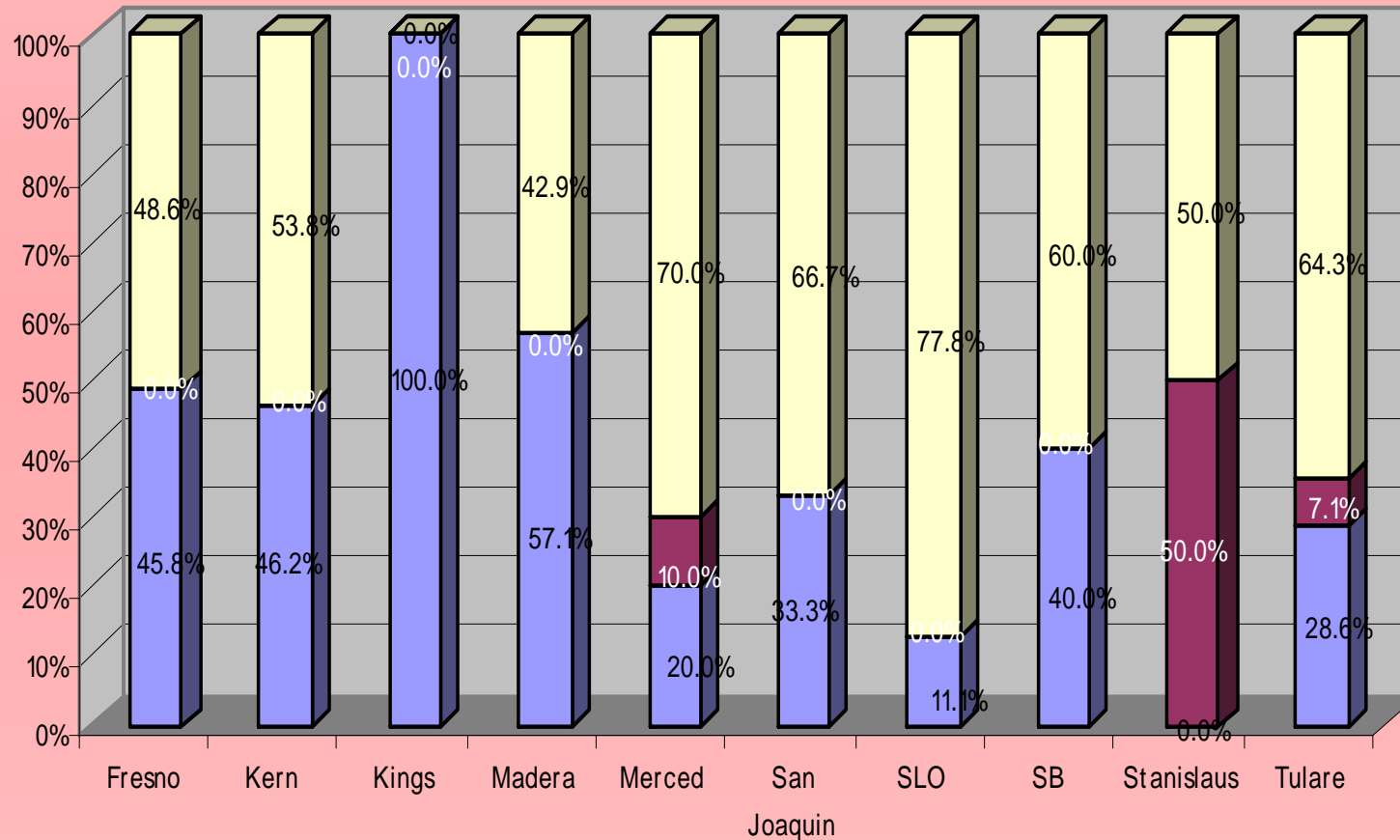
Children entering FC for the first time - 4/1/04 - 3/31/05 - the predominant placement type.



FC Placement in Least Restrictive Settings - 4B - State Measure Point in Time Placement - 4/1/05

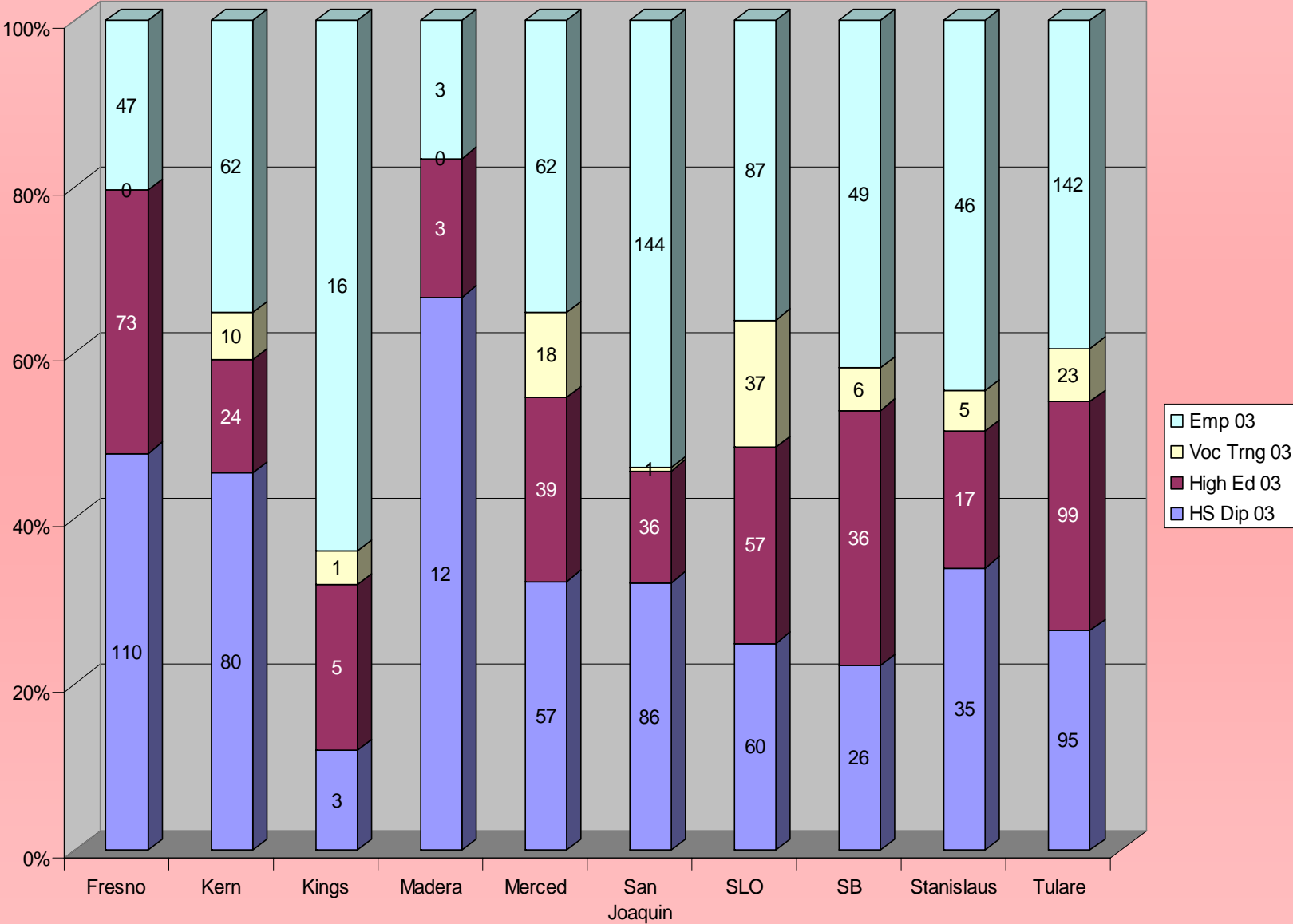


Rate of ICWA Placement Preferences - 4E - State Measure
