Note: Faculty who have not taught online or have limited experience are encouraged to take Q1 while faculty who have more online experience can enroll in Q2

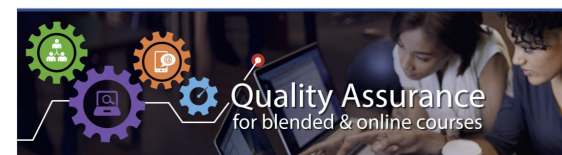


Existing course **up to 20% online**
