Guidelines for Acting Scholarship Audition

*The Fresno State Application Filing deadline is **December 4, 2020.***

The Acting emphasis offers intensive training in all aspects of the craft: scene study, voice, movement, period style acting, musical theatre, devised theatre, among others. Many of our graduates have gone on to careers in theatre, television, and film.

Acting Audition Video Submission Guidelines:

- You will have up to four (4) minutes to perform two monologues. **Videos should not exceed 4 minutes.**
- Prepare two (2) contrasting monologues.
- Songs are acceptable in lieu of one (1) monologue. It is preferred that songs are recorded with accompaniment.
- Video should be recorded from the waist up, in a well-lit and quiet room. Video should be filmed in landscape (horizontal) format.
