

2018-19 Changes Impacting Fresno State's Operating Fund Budget

2018-19 Enacted State Budget Allocations

The 2018-19 state budget, enacted on June 27, 2018, includes a \$197.3 million base appropriation increase for CSU operations, which will fund increases in Graduation Initiative 2025, employee compensation and retirement benefits.

Campus resident full-time equivalent student (FTES) enrollment target for 2018-19 will remain at 19,265 while non-resident enrollment has a slight increase of 83 to 945.
