Changes to the Final Section "Appeals Process"

Students who wish to appeal a decision relative to changing of a major or minor, **academic disqualification for failure to abide by a graduation plan**, or-administrative graduation, **or rejection of ability to enroll past 144 units** shall follow the procedures of an appeal to the Academic Petitions Committee. Students will be given adequate notice of any of the actions **outlined above in time to appeal the decision before implementation.** Students who cannot complete their current major because of an inability to complete/pass a requirement may file a request with the Academic Petitions Committee to change majors even though they may need to exceed the 144 unit limit to complete their new major.
