

Cal State Apply Tips for Returning Applicants

1. **Extended Profile:** All returning applicants must answer all questions as shown below in order to be allowed to submit your application.

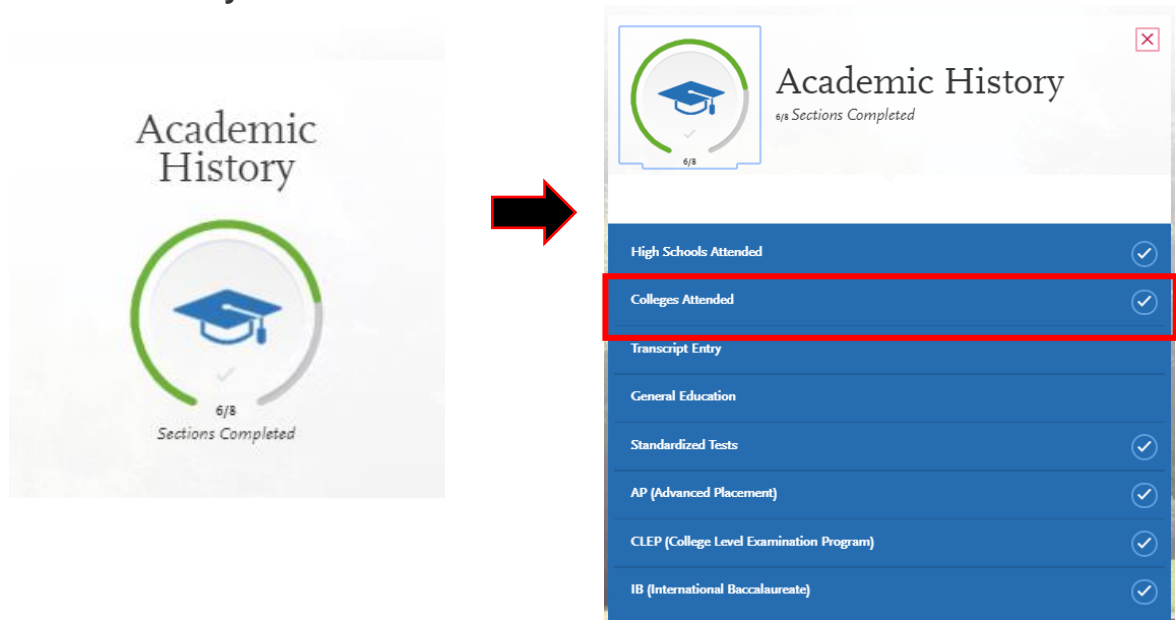

When indicating Fresno State as a college attended you must answer No the question “Did you obtain or are you planning to obtain a degree from this college or university?”

5. Do I have to enter all my courses?

6. Do I indicate foundation courses in the General Education section?

Yes, indicate Golden 4 courses. If courses were taken through Fresno State, you will need to add Fresno State to Colleges Attended before entering coursework.

7. When entering repeated courses and academic renewal course, what do I do?

*GRADE: Enter in the grade as listed on your transcript. All attempts and grades should be included.

- a. Enter repeated courses noted on the transcript with a grade of RP.
- b. Enter Academic Renewal courses with a grade of AR.
